Passover Ceremony Beginning of Aviv 14, directly after Sunset when Aviv 13 ends

Since the Passover is the renewing of your covenant vows that you took at your baptism, it stands to reason that only baptized members of the congregation should partake of it. It is suggested to listen to the sermon called Yahshua's Last Passover to understand the order of how the Passover with Yahshua was kept.

Start with Blessing on service, Drink 1st Cup (Luk 22:17)

- Jn 13:1-20- Foot washing- explain meeting
- Jn 13:21-26- Exo 12:8- Dip Bitter herbs eat
- Ex 12:14-26- Bread of affliction, represents sin
- Explain that in the Old Covenant full meal Sedar that the meal and second cup would be taken now, 1 Cor 11:20-22, 34
- PS 111-115 would now be read
- Jn 6:26-58- Yahshua is the bread of life
- Math 26:26- eat the bread (matzot)
- Math 26:27-28- cup represents His blood, (Jer 31-31-34), 3rd cup of grace
- Read Ps 51 cup of grace is 3rd cup
- 4th cup is empty, it is the cup of salvation, that only Yahshua could take
- Read PS 116-118, Read Math 20:20-22
- Read JN 14-15-16-17-18-19 (or parts of chapters)
- Sing Hymn Math 26:30
