



Wilderness



And I do not want you to be ignorant, brothers that our fathers were all under the cloud, and all passed through the Sea. And all were baptized to Moses in the cloud, and in the Sea, and all ate the same spiritual food. And all drank the same spiritual drink; for they drank of the spiritual rock following, and that Rock was Messiah. Yet Elohim was not pleased with most of them, "For they were scattered in the deserted place." But these things became examples for us, so that we may not be lusting after evil, even as those indeed lusted. Neither be idolaters, even as some of them, as it has been written, "The people sat down to eat and drink, and rose up to play." Nor should we commit fornication, as some of them fornicated, and twenty three thousand fell in one day. Neither let us tempt the Messiah, as some of them did, and were destroyed by serpents. Neither should you murmur, as also some of them murmured, and perished by the hand of the destroyer. And all these things happened to those as examples, and it was written for our warning, on whom the ends of the ages have come. And what harmony has the sanctuary of Elohim with idols? For you are the sanctuary of the living Elohim, even as it is said, "I will dwell in them and walk among them, and I'll be their Elohim, and they shall be My people." Because of this, "Come out from among them and be separated, says YAHWEH, and do not touch the unclean thing, and I will receive you." "And I will be a Father to you, and you will be sons and daughters to Me, says YAHWEH Almighty" – 2nd Corinthians 6:16-18

We have to work on not complaining. We have to know our position in the congregation and wait for Yahweh to help/show you the way. We have to trust that everything happens for a reason that may not be known to us, but it is still the will of Yahweh. We have to change our Babylonian mindset. We brought way too much stuff with us to the wilderness that we didn't need/use. Yahweh will take care of us and provide what we need. Don't take anything for granted, everything is a blessing. We need to focus on true worship to Yahweh and not focus on self-glory. Are we preparing/willing to go to the wilderness knowing that Yahweh is calling us? What do we need to change in ourselves to get there? We have to declutter our lives, so it is easier to hear the small still voice. All idols and things used for self-glory need to be removed from our lives. We have a physical blood family, but being here we have realized that we have brothers, sisters, aunts, uncles, and grandparents all in the faith, and it is more important to have them in our lives than even our blood family.

Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy; six days you shall labor and do all your work; and the seventh day is a Sabbath to YAHWEH your Elohim; you shall not do any work, you, and your son, and your daughter, your male slave and your slave-girl, and your livestock, and your stranger who is in your gates. For in six days YAHWEH made the heavens and the earth, the sea, and all which is in them, and He rested on the seventh day; on account of this YAHWEH blessed the Sabbath day and sanctified it – Exodus 20:8-11

I learned patience and that you can't have everything you want when you want it, but that is also OK. I also learned that even if you try to plan for things that may happen, you can't plan for everything, but when you rely on Yahweh, He will get you through it.

I was amazed at how much we can complain without even saying a word! I am trying to not complain and be satisfied with all things, as Yahweh gives us what we have for a reason, so we should be glad that we have what Yahweh gave us. It is harder than what I would have thought to trust in Yahweh, even in little things, like packing so much stuff that I thought I would need, and didn't even use many of them.

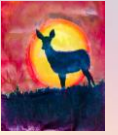

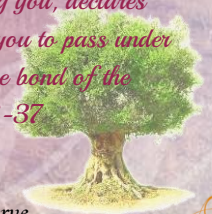

But I say, if you walk in the Spirit, the lust of the flesh will not overtake you. For the flesh lusts against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh; and these are opposed to one another; so you are not able to do as you desire. But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under (the penalty of breaking) the Torah – Galatians 5:16-18

Taking a step to follow how the Israelites have wandered in the wilderness, and I learned that going from one camp to another was very difficult to travel for the Israelites and their families. My wilderness experience has taught me a lot of spiritual significance. From the first camp to the next, tasting the food to feeling the blazing heat of the mountains in Kadesh. It makes me think of Abraham's true faith that made him to be a father of many nations.

The greatest lesson I learned was how to walk in the spirit as it states in Gal 5:16, and if you live in the spirit you should walk in that same spirit. Let murmuring be put away and also complaining, etc. To me, I am grateful, as I see this is a new era of my physical life. I could feel the heaviness in my heart and how I could not believe what happened to our brother Israelites as they moved from one camp to another. Also, how hard it was for Moses, because of the rebellious people. Instead of speaking to the living rock he struck the rock and that was how the rebellious Israelites were. But due to their antagonizing spirit towards Moses, it kept him out of the Promised Land. For that example, it's a good reason to stay away from the mixed multitude and Laodiceans in this end time.
