Greetings Brethren, and Shalom in the wonderful names of Yahweh and Yahshua, the name above all names.

2 Cor 5:20, states that we are Ambassadors of Messiah, and Revelation 5:10 goes even further to say that we will be Kings and Priests in His soon coming Kingdom.

Wow, being an Ambassador for the one and only true Messiah of the universe is one thing, but to be a King and a Priest in His soon coming Kingdom just seems too unbelievable to imagine! As accepting Yahshua into your life, or better yet, starting a new life in Yahshua and being immersed into His name and having hands laid on you by an Elder of Yahweh for the imparting of the Ruach H' Chodesh is merely the beginning of your calling and not the end of it.

Now on the other hand, as many are coming out of false pagan Christianity, and are coming back to the truth of Yahweh's Torah, they are also being hoodwinked by the money grapping financially based Babylonian Ministries in the US.

Most of these teachers are selling so called Torah based teachings on Hebrew words, and how to perform Jewish customs and rituals, but very few are teaching proper doctrine, or preparing Yahweh's firstfruits for their ultimate destiny of being a King and a Priest to Him throughout eternity.

When you look at the true unbelievable human potential, it is just staggering.

Ro 8: 14 For as many as are led by the Spirit of Yahweh, these are sons of Yahweh. 15 For you did not receive a spirit of slavery again to fear, but **you received a Spirit of sonship** by which we cry, Abba! Father!

16 The Spirit itself witnesses with our spirit that <u>we are children of Yahweh</u>. 17 <u>And if children, also heirs; truly heirs of Yahweh, and joint-heirs of</u> <u>Messiah</u>, if indeed we suffer together, that we may also be glorified together.

Did you catch the full magnitude of that verse? If you have been immersed in the name of Yahshua and have Yahweh's spirit dwelling in you, then you are a literal begotten child of His and a *co-heir* of the universe to reign with Yahshua Messiah! WOW!!!

Those are some of the most powerful words in scripture to our full potential as human beings here on this earth. However, remember, *"to much is given much will be required, and to the more is given the more will be expected. (Lk 12:48)"*

- 15 And it happened as he returned, having received the kingdom, he even said for those servants to be called to him, those to whom he gave the silver, that he might know what each had gained by trading.
- 16 And the first came, saying, Master, your mina has gained ten minas.
- 17 And he said to him, Well done, good slave! Because you were faithful in a least thing, *have authority over ten cities.*
- 18 And the second came, saying, Master, your mina has made five minas.
- 19 And he said to this one also, And you be over five cities.
- 20 And another came, saying, Master, *behold your mina which I have stored up in a face-cloth.*
- 24 And to those standing by, he said, *Take the mina from him, and give it to him who has ten minas.*
- 26 For I say to you, **To everyone who has, it will be given. And from the one who does not have, even what he has will be taken from him.**

The parable of the talents very clearly shows us that Yahweh has empowered us with certain gifts through His Ruach H'Chodesh (Holy Spirit) that He requires us to use to bear fruit for and build the character necessary to be a leader in His Kingdom.


Now with time being short in this world and the doors that Yahweh has opened to us to start the "*Return to the Land Program*", we are even going to put a greater focus on this most special calling.

Yes, You - Were Born to be a King (reprint)

The heir apparent to the throne of the British Empire, is profoundly conscious of his destiny. Some day he will be King.

The night of his birth, Nov. 14, 1948, wildly cheering crowds thronged Buckingham Palace until 2a.m. The English-speaking world rejoiced at this addition to Britain's royal family. At the age of 4, at the death of his grandfather, the beloved George VI, Charles became Heir Apparent to the world's most prestigious throne.

Training for kingship

It was from that young age that an important period of training began for Charles, who was someday to inherit a gigantic responsibility, along with all the power and glory, which goes with being the monarch of what was then the world's greatest empire.

Charles father, Prince Phillip, planned his son's education. It was obvious that Charles had inherited the shy temperament of his mother and father and grandfather.

Philip felt the need for a strenuous training program befitting a future king. He wanted his son "looked after without being spoiled." So at age 8, Charles was enrolled in a London public school. This shocked the Commonwealth. It was the first time an heir to the British throne was to be educated alongside his future subjects. Phillip feared too much "*petticoat influence*" at the palace.

In this decision, his uncle, the vigorous and innovative Lord Louis Mountbatten, supported him. In addition, at age 9, Charles was separated from his parents and sent to a boarding school in Berkshire. All of this proceeded with his mother's consent, but his father, Prince Phillip, was the catalyst.

Charles' report cards were, of course, international news. One instructor summed him up as "nervous' sullen, sometimes precocious." Like most schoolchildren, he had a nickname: "*Fatty*". He shared the same type of army spring bed and horsehair mattress as his peers.

By age 14, the future Prince of Wales was ready for another major step. This time his father enrolled him in Gordonstoun, a special boys' school on the bleak northeast coast of Scotland. The curriculum came complete with a rugged regime of morning exercises, cold showers and, according to the school's founder, *"character development*".

At Gordonstoun, every student had a work assignment; the first job for the destined king? Emptying dustbins. It was at this remote outpost that Charles was forcibly reminded of a valuable lesson in leadership: Leaders live in goldfish bowls. Charles' awareness of what life was like in the public eye was crystallized in the notorious "Cherry Brandy Affair," when he was demoted for violating the school's rules after he shared a quick drink in a pub. His mentors quickly took him aside and explained that such behavior just simply did not benefit a future king.

By age 18, however, Phillip estimated that the young prince was ready for a year in Australia. Timbertop, another selective school for rugged young men, sped his personality development. Evidence that Philips patient, determent program was paying off came in July, 1969. At this investiture, as Prince of Wales, at historic Carnarvon Castle, Charles won the hearts of his Welsh subjects by addressing them in their own ancient tongue. His 300-word speech in the original Welsh language was more than most native Welshmen could manage. This bold feat showed, in the words of the authority, that "Prince Charles was not going to be beaten by anything or anybody when he set out to achieve a goal."

Next, Charles earned a degree from Cambridge, spent a stint in The Royal Air force jet trainers and had a personal command of the royal Navy's HMS Bronington. Much of this followed the careful steps outlined by his father.

Few people today understand the personal and emotional sacrifices, strains and stresses attendant upon the rigorous and sometimes dangerous - job as chief of state for the British Commonwealth nations. The throne stands as the unifying link for millions of people of varying races, colors and creeds. In times of war, economic upset and other national emergencies, the British royal family has proven its worth. Even today, the sovereign Royal example serves as a valuable moderating and stabilizing influence in a tumultuous age. Perhaps Prince Phillip's single accomplishment has been helping the transformation of this basically reticent personality into a man" for all seasons" the very popular and increasingly respected Charles, Prince of Wales. Prince Charles takes his motto. Ich Dien (I serve), very seriously.

Now hold your breath!

The believer's destiny; You Too, if you have repented and been baptized, are destined to become a king, in Yahweh's Kingdom!

"Henceforth there is laid up for me a crown of righteousness, which Yahweh, the righteous judge, shall give me at that day: and not to me only, but unto all them also that love His appearing" (2Tim 4:8).

"And the kingdom and dominion, and the greatness of the kingdom under the whole heaven, shall be given to the people of the saints of the most high": (Dan 7:27).

True Believers are even called Kings, already, **"And Yahshua hath made us Kings and priests unto Yahweh, even His Father**" (Rev1:6).

When you repented, were baptized and Yahweh's minister laid his hands on you,

you received Yahweh's gift of the Holy Spirit (Acts 2: 38). You were begotten as an actual member of Yahweh's family. At that time, the cherubs in heaven rejoiced (Lk 15: 10), just as the English speaking world did when Charles became Heir Apparent of the throne of Britain, because at that moment you began a training program that will culminate in your becoming a joint ruler, of the Universe, with Yahshua (Ro 8: 16-17). Believers are now preparing to, with and under Yahshua, exercise power over the nations, and judge the whole world (Rev. 2:26 – 27, 20; 4, 1Cor6;2).

What a spectacular set of promises! Truly, believers are destined to be given ruler ship with Yahshua upon His return from heaven. Thus, Peter writes that members of the true body of Messiah are part of a *"Royal Priesthood"* (1Peter 2:9).

Essentials for rulership

Charles, the Prince of Wales, submitted to a difficult program designed by his father to fit him for the British throne. The sure knowledge of his certain future stiffened his resolve and helped him to stoically, endure the constant glare of publicity, the antagonism to royalty from certain vociferous elements, and the daily pressure of being a target for some crackpot assassin.

Our Father in heaven, head of the Royal Family of this universe (Eph 3: 15), is calling His children to a far more important prize than Britain's fabled throne. Our training program, then, must be even more vital then was Prince Charles's. The bible outlines several areas Yahweh wants to develop in His children.

1. Among the indispensable qualities for ruling along with Yahshua in His Kingdom is **strong, dependable character.**

Revelation 17: 14 says those who rule with Yahshua will be "*called, and chosen, and faithful.*"

Trustworthiness nets a handsome dividend even in this physical life.

The irksome, unglamorous tasks that must be performed if our home, company or schoolwork are to succeed are sometimes small, but are nevertheless real tests of character (Lk 16: 10). We can always take the pressure off ourselves and "cop out" from tackling the "must" jobs, but our character will have been weakened as a result. Our character is what we are. "Little things" like daily prayer, Bible study, congregation and Bible study attendance, tithing, visiting and being hospitable to others begin to add up to an unmistakable pattern over a lifetime.

For instance, on the job with fellow workers and employers, our character is showing. Paul admonished the Ephesians, "Servants, be obedient to them that are your masters according to the flesh, with fair and trembling, in singleness of your heart, as unto Yahshua" (Eph 6: 5).

In the employment market, good, solid, dependable men and women are always in demand. With Yahweh's loving help and our own earnest striving, our sturdiness and resolve can be supernaturally strengthened (Is. 40:31). Yahweh's spirit rules human tendency to procrastinate and bolsters our flagging determination in the face of frustrating obstacles (Phil 4:13). As we learn "our daily bread, "then, we are learning valuable lessons of character that will last throughout all the time.

Future kings also need to develop their minds,

However, more than mere I.Q. or scholastic ability, Yahweh is concerned that His children grow in wisdom, the most important mental attribute (Prov 4: 7).

Solomon, the wisest king who ever lived, began his renowned career by lamenting his lack of wisdom in the clearest terms, "*I am but a little child: I know not how to go out or come in*" (Kg 3: 7). This sincere admission helped convince His creator that Solomon was a fit vessel for receiving the brilliant, startling, piercing insights only YHWH can give (Pro. 2: 6). Solomon's encounter with the two harlots (1 Kg 3: 16 - 28) is an example of dynamic wisdom in action – the divine insight needed to untangle many complicated situations, whether in the boardroom or in the living room.

Wisdom involves having the understanding to know what to say and perhaps more importantly, when to say it (Eccl.3: 7). Through His word, Yahweh answers the big questions in life. Which of us hasn't bewailed our lack of wisdom from time to time, or bemoaned the fact that we "dropped the ball" in certain life's decisions, some of which we may be suffering for right now? If you feel this way sometimes, then take heart. Admitting our lack of insight is one of the first steps in receiving true wisdom. The entire book of Proverbs is written to the "simple," the person who "wanted understanding" (Prov 9: 4).

2. Good rulers need sincere warmth of personality.

It is said, Abraham Lincoln refused to hire a man once because of the look on his face. Mr. Lincoln's subordinates protested that a man couldn't help the way he looked. However, Mr. Lincoln, wise president that he was, stuck to his guns and was proven right.

Proverbs 15: 13 says, "A merry heart makes a cheerful countenance." Stop and think: The people who influence us the most possess an extra measure of enthusiasm and spark. Buoyant optimism animates the personalities of most true leaders. A sincere, sparkling personality is a powerful force all by itself. "Infectious optimism" was one of field marshal Bernard Montgomery's prized attributes of leadership. As Andrew Jackson said, *"One man with courage makes a majority."* The same goes for enthusiasm

Yahshua, our soon coming King of Kings, stirred the multitudes with the strength of His personality (Mk. 12: 37) His sincerity and generosity spread His fame abroad (Mk 5: 20). Yahshua's strong, outgoing personality truly made Him "the Master".

3. Future rulers in Yahweh's government must have drive.

Many of Yahweh's greatest servants were in superb physical condition (Deut 34: 7, 1 Kg 18: 46). Some people have good character, sharp minds and sparkling personality, but lack the staying power that gives outstanding leaders their winning edge.

Conrad Adenauer, the beloved Der Alte of postwar Germany, performed his greatest service to his fatherland between the ages of 73 and 87 when, as chancellor, he led West Germany back to a respected place in world affairs. Had he retired at 65, probably nobody would have heard much of him.

Yahshua's determination awed His disciples many times, but never more so than in the last few days before his death. He "steadfastly set His face" to brave certain death in the Pharisees" stronghold of Jerusalem (Lk 9: 51). His quiet, concentrated will and purpose even strengthened the wavering disciples (Jn 11:16). Certainly, the kings who will rule with Yahshua will posses a good measure of that bulldog tenacity that characterizes great leaders.

4. This area of development – leadership – teaches us tact, patience and genuine mercy, which will stand us in good stead in working with people for all eternity.

Our families provide us with wonderful leadership opportunities. Are our families happy? If not, we are stifling our development into future kings. YHWH holds husbands responsible for cheering up their wives and loving them as Yahshua loved the body (Deut 24: 5, Eph 5: 25). Wives are encouraged to submit themselves to their husbands and live up to the example of the virtuous women (Eph 5: 22, Prov 31: 10- 31). Children learn first the approach to authority figures in the home (Eph 6:1).

The attitude of being teachable, learned in a loving and disciplined family relationship, gives children a head start with school. In this way children start out as early as possible on the road to success in life (Ex 20: 12, Prov 20: 11). Paul emphasis the relationship between family life and leadership in describing a ministers office, *"If a man know not how to rule his own house, how shall he take care of a congregation of Yahweh?"* (1 Tim 3: 5).

5. Believers have to learn to handle Yahweh's spirit wisely.

Through the laying on of hands, Yahweh has given us the spirit of power, which we constantly need to stir up (2Tim 1: 6-7) The word for "spirit" here is transliterated *dunamis* from which comes the English "dynamite" or "dynamic"." This priceless force can help us make real progress in our personal lives if we continue to replenish it (2Cor 4: 16).

Increasing and expanding the "earnest," or small amount of the spirit we have now(Eph 1: 13-14), is the best insurance that Yahshua will completely convert us to dynamic spirit substance at His return. This supernatural power from YHWH helps us get the true perspective on this human life. It really changes things. YHWH is about to clean up the pitiful mess that is in this world, and right now. He is busily training a gualified, competent staff that will have the privilege to teach humans after the resurrection (Rev 20: 12). We will be the ones, along with Yahshua, to ensure that the tragic sadness that has characterized this world will never be repeated.

6. Heirs apparent to YHWH's throne The kingdom of YHWH is all about people. Billions of people. People looking for direction and guidance, people looking for healing and physical sustenance, people looking for real, practical help for their personal problems. Are we ready to teach and train the world (Dan 12:3) ? Probably not...yet!

Small wonder that Yahshua reveals the kingdom will be entered only by violence (Mat 11:12) – by those who are violent themselves, forcing their naturally self concerned and lazy human nature into the paths of true character, helpful wisdom, sparkling warmth, inspiring drive and right leadership, all motivated by Yahweh's spirit of power and service.

Truly, the whole creation, past and present, *"waits for the manifestation of the sons of YHWH"* (Ro 8; 19).

We dare not drift with the rest of this purposeless, confused world. We were born to be kings, kings who will be servants of the people they rule (Eph 1: 4-5), Mat 20: 25 - 27).

Our calling is much higher then Prince Charles. We will be inheriting with Yahshua, the very throne of the universe – a high destiny indeed. We need to strive harder to be worthy Heirs Apparent to the throne of Yahshua, at Jerusalem, ruling the earth:

"To him that overcomes will I grant to sit with me in my throne, even as I also overcame, and set down with my father in His throne" (Rev 3: 21).

Coming - Your Rulership in Yahweh's Kingdom



Utopia - the model society!

Humanity has always dreamed of living in an ideal word – one with perfect laws, government and social conditions. This ideal world would have lasting peace, abundance and exciting opportunities for all.

But all man's governments, cultures and social experiments have failed to produce this result. Instead, we live in a world filled with misery and increasing evils – a world tottering on the brink of destroying itself! Even the dictionary defines the concept of a utopian society as "*impossibly ideal*."

But is utopia impossible?

No! In fact, exactly such a society is just ahead of us now – Yahweh promises it! Bible prophecy shows that this earth will be changed into a real utopia, and that you can have a part in making it happen. You can assist Yahshua, beginning at His second coming, in ruling this world (Rev 5: 10).

That is the meaning of the Feast of Tabernacles, the sixth of Yahweh's seven annual festivals. The Feast of Tabernacles pictures Yahweh's spirit born

family ruling on earth during the millennium – the Kingdom of YHWH. Exciting, isn't it? What a wonderful opportunity it would be to take part in eliminating human suffering, so that all people can experience true happiness. War will be outlawed. Famine will disappear. Illiteracy will be wiped out. Life will become thrilling!

What a joy it will be to help create these conditions! Never before has such awesome opportunity for doing good existed. As a glorified member of the Elohim family (Rom 8:17 - 21), you'll be in a position to enforce Yahweh's law, which will automatically produce happiness.

But as a ruler in Yahweh's kingdom, how will you relate to YHWH the father, Yahshua and other member's of Yahweh's family? How will you work with human beings under your care? What laws will you teach and enforce? Let us explore our future as rulers in Yahweh's kingdom. Let us try to envision the thrill and excitement of being ruling members of Yahweh's family.

Perfect teamwork

Rulership in Yahweh's family will involve teamwork – working together for everyone's good. We will be serving under YHWH the Father (Jn 14: 28) and Yahshua (Rev 19: 15 – 16), Eph 1: 20 22). Those who have qualified during their human lives will hold top administrative positions; David, for instance, will be king over all Israel (Ez. 37: 24). Others will see that the knowledge of Yahweh's way goes forth from Jerusalem to all the world (Is 2:3 - 4). Still others will serve as local rulers (Lk 19: 11 – 19). Those at headquarters will work together in unity with those ruling around the world. No longer will division and strive among rulers be tolerated. No longer will anyone work at cross-purposes; no longer will anyone compete for recognition, influence or importance. All will be in harmony with Yahweh the Father and Yahshua (Jn 17: 10- 11).

Each of us will have specified areas of responsibility to diligently handle. A chain of authority will govern everyone's conduct. Most important, Yahweh's love will bind us together and flow out to those under our rule.

Imagine such ruler ship on a global scale. Yahweh's divine power will extend this rulership to everyone, not just a few, and unheard of productivity and happiness will abound (Jer 31: 12-13).

A new way of life

Destructive trends from 6,000 years of human misrule will be reversed. Through miraculous intervention, the environment will be changed. Mountains will be lowered and valleys raised. Dramatic climate changes will alter barren deserts, turning them into thriving locations for desirable plants and animals. Miraculous healings will occur and sickness will be abolished (Is 40: 4, 35: 1-7, 9). The very nature of animals will be changed so they no longer harm or fear man (Is 11: 6-8).

Once the initial geological changes have been made, the land will be ready for resettling. We will resettle the destitute refugees who survive the great tribulation and the Day of YHWH and help them begin a way of life they have not known. A temple will be constructed; there Yahshua shall sit as supreme ruler (Ez 40 – 42). Jerusalem will be rebuilt; much smaller but more beautiful, with verdant agricultural land just outside the city limits (Ez 48: 15 – 19).

The entire land of Israel will be divinely allocated and families will be given a

portion of land as an inheritance, to grow throughout the Millennium without fear of losing it (verses 1 - 7, 23 - 28). Agriculture will become the basis of society. Small, family owned farms will produce bountiful harvests without soil erosion or the use of harmful pesticides or chemical fertilizers (Amos 9: 13). Proper farming will bring joy to the farmers of the future.

Business and industry will still exist, but on a far different scale. The emphasis will be on serving others. For example, beating swords into plowshares (Is 2: 4) will involve manufacturing equipment for constructive purposes from war machinery that was once used for destruction.

No longer will huge, impersonal, getorientated industries pollute the atmosphere, and provide monotonous work to waste people's potential. Workers will enjoy their work as they produce quality goods in a safe and stimulating environment.

Industrial pollution will be halted. Natural energy sources such as sunlight will be wisely used and reusable materials will be recycled, thereby greatly reducing industrial waste.

Even the source of many raw materials will change. Abundant mineral resources from the oceans will be made available for productive use (Is 60: 5).

Cities will be rebuilt, intelligently planned so that the people won't experience the problems of overcrowding and separation from the beauty and tranquility of an agrarian society. Cities will be architecturally breathtaking, built according to a divinely inspired master plan (Amos 9: 14).

Economic uncertainty will be replaced by Yahweh's financial system, with stability, full employment and job satisfaction. No longer will man be plagued by runaway inflation, excessive taxes and high interest rates.

Humanity's potential achieved

Happily married couples living in harmony will reproduce children they truly love and know how to rear. Together these families will enjoy activities that bring them much happiness (Jer 31: 13).

All of these blessings will result from man's obedience to Yahweh's way of life – the way of life that will be much easier to teach them by you!

All of these blessings will result from man's obedience to Yahweh's laws then, because satan's influence will be removed, allowing a right attitude to permeate society (Jer 31: 33).

As a ruler, you will be able to provide people the opportunity to develop their talents through schooling, encouragement and practical experience. Your relationship with humans will include spending time with them in social situations that you'll both enjoy.

Your rulership will not be some distant, impersonal relationship with humans under your rule or with fellow spirits beings. Not at all. You will enjoy being with them sharing experiences, discussing ideas, doing things together and making plans for the future (Ps 16: 11, 145: 10 - 12).

Does all this mean that there will be no problems in Yahweh's Kingdom? No, Problems from the lingering influence of satan-inspired human nature will be prevalent at the onset of the Millennium.

The warning that some nations will not receive rain unless they keep the Feast of Tabernacles (Zech. 14: 17) implies that some will not initially want to obey YHWH. It will indeed take time for Yahweh's way of life to permeate the whole world (Matt 13: 33).

The heavenly power of discernment, though, will enable you to make the right decisions when you're faced with a problem.

You will be able to stop problems before they get out of control (Is 30: 20-21).

Remain faithful now

Truly, a joyous time of rulership awaits all of us for all eternity.

However, merely knowing about these things is not enough. You must diligently respond to the High calling Yahweh is giving you. You must work to develop the attributes of a king by yielding to the will of Yahweh. (Math 7: 21, 18: 3), Ja 1: 22-25).

As a ruler of the future you must look beyond the difficulties now facing you, to your ultimate reward (Ro 8: 18). That is what Yahshua did (Heb 12: 2-3, 1 Peter 2: 21).

Allow this hope to burn brightly in you, for Yahweh's plan extends even beyond what this article has covered.

Your rulership shall extend to all the universe that now lies dead (Rev 21-22)! This must be the absolute focal point of your life, if indeed it will be a reality at Yahshua's return. Yahweh expects us now to do everything in our power to prepare for this amazing wonderful opportunity that He will give us to be rulers in His soon coming Kingdom.

Remember the example of Yahshua and be obedient to His will. If you do, someday He'll apply these words to you: *"Well done, good and faithful servant; you were faithful over a few things, I will make you ruler over many things. Enter into the joy of your Master"* (Matt 25: 21).

We are Ambassadors for a foreign Power! (Reprint)



Our ultimate destiny as Believers is to become kings and rule along with Yahshua in the Kingdom of Yahweh, but we also have an important diplomatic job here and now. We, as Yahweh's people, represent a foreign government, for "*our citizenship is in heaven*" (Phil 3: 20) and we all hold the office of ambassador.

Ambassadorships are critical appointments and are therefore conferred only to those who can rightly and positively represent the ideals, laws, people, culture, government policies and political ideologies of the country where they hold citizenship. If ever they fail to uphold all these standards, they can automatically disqualify themselves from representing their governments and be recalled from their posts.

As ambassadors for Yahweh's future government, our lives are to exemplify Yahweh's way to this world. We are to represent the order, peace and abundant joy inherited in the spiritual government to which we truly owe our allegiance. We are, in Yahshuas words, to be lights to the world (Math 5: 14 - 16). And the Father of lights" (Jm 1: 17) will not permit us to hide our good examples under a bushel. We have been set on a hill for all to see, just as a light pierces the surrounding darkness so people can see where they are going.

Did you ever notice how people have a way of immediately categorizing anyone they meet or any idea with which they come in contact? If you meet someone from the southern United States, you automatically fit the person into the image you have of the South, even though you may have never been there. You may think of a Confederate flag, a steamboat, the Atlanta Hawks basket ball team, humid weather or "Southern hospitality." You assign the person to a certain slot in your mind.

If someone drives a Cadillac, it means a certain thing in people's minds. Driving a Volkswagen also communicates an image. "Everybody knows "businessman dress a certain way; models, bricklayers and athletes also have a certain uniform, in our minds. The way a person walks says that he is cocky, refined, shy, confident or relaxed.

People are categorized, and many times incorrectly, according to their religion, skin color, political party, manners, sports they like, books they read, friends, jokes they tell, entertainment they prefer or even the kind of dog they own.

Do you realize what this means to you as a Believing ambassador? People are analyzing your every word, move or habit. Thus you must set an example that will unmistakably identify just who you are and who you represent.

Yahweh intended that Israel be such a sterling example in their obedience to Him that all the surrounding nations could not help but notice how they too, were really intended to live life (Deut 4: 4-8). Unfortunately, the bible shows that never happened. Israel utterly failed their commission. As a matter of fact, they failed their commission so miserably that in the New Testament Paul often referred to Israel's example to show how much better it would have been had Israel written a positive, righteous record!

One bright spot in Israel's history was King Solomon's early example of wisdom and understanding, which spread abroad so strongly that the queen of Sheba couldn't believe it. She decided to check up for herself (1Kg 10: 1- 10) and found out she hadn't heard the half of it (vs. 7). Solomon must have been setting quite an example but though he was king, he was still just one man. What if the entire nation had been as wise and righteous as Solomon? It would have had that much greater impact on Israel's neighbors.

Even the early congregation had a hard time learning to generate the right light. The apostle Paul must have had great patience as he dealt with the Corinthian congregation, he had much to say to them about their wrong conduct. He explained to them in 11 Cor 5: 20 that *"we are ambassadors for Yahshua."* The entire reference was probably not to the ministry or apostles alone, even though they are ambassadors in the most direct sense. Paul was trying to get across to the Corinthians the importance of the examples we all set (vs10) and stated that *"if any man be in Yahshua , he is anew creation"* (vs17).

Paul instructed the Philippians to "Only let your conversation (conduct) be as it becomes the gospel of Yahshua" (Phil 1: 27). That gospel is of the coming government of Yahweh. Is your conduct "becoming" of that government or do you cast a bad light on it? When ambassadors High standards are set so that high standards can be reached.

Those standards touch upon all facets of student life: Studies, finances, health, appearance, work, athletics, dating and spiritual growth. If anyone doesn't strive to reach those standards, he simply cannot remain as an ambassador.

Col 4: 5-6 "Walk in wisdom toward them that are without, redeeming the time. Let your speech be always with grace, seasoned with salt, that ye may know how ye ought to answer every man." People outside the body shouldn't be able to overlook our wisdom.

1 Cor 6:2 shows the saints will judge the world one day. If that day were here and all those who knew you in this life now could see you as a member of Yahweh's family, what would there reaction be?

Would they remember hearing you and your wife or husband fighting? The disrespectful, foul language and unkempt appearance of your children? Your uncared yard, your off color jokes, your unfriendly, secretive manner, your unpainted house, your poor work record and on and on?

Yahshua gained favor with Yahweh and man (Lk 2: 52). He set us an example (1Pe 2: 21). Are you found in favor with both Yahweh and man? A man or woman can convert his or her mate without "a" word or "the" Word (the bible), but purely by their conduct being different from the average person's (1Pe 4: 4).

Does your example convict them? You may be the only bible some people ever read". Can people read you clearly? Do you even "*abstain* from all appearance of evil" (1 Thess 5: 22)? No error or fault could be found in Daniel (Dan 6: 4). His conduct was so outstanding in all respects that a whole group of cunning, carnal minded politicians couldn't find anything of which to accuse him unless it was "concerning the law of His Elohim" (vs. 5).

He wasn't doing anything they could gainsay. Nothing!

This is what being the light of the world is all about. This is what it means to be an ambassador for Yahshua.

Answers to your Questions

Q- Does the bible teach that the soul is immortal, and that people are reincarnated after death?

<u>A-</u> The bible does not teach that there is any consciousness of the soul after death, but that the dead are in a state of sleep in the ground.

<u>Ecc 9:5a</u> For the living know that they shall die; **but the dead do not know** anything;

Act 7:60 And placing the knees, he cried out with a loud voice, Master, do not make stand this sin to them. And having said this, **he fell asleep**.

Joh 11:11 He said these things. And after this, He said to them, Our friend Lazarus **has fallen asleep**, but I am going that I may awaken him.

<u>1Th</u> 4:14 For if we believe that Yahshua died and rose again, even so Elohim will also bring with Him **all those who have** fallen asleep through Yahshua.

The idea of the immortal soul goes back thousands of years to ancient paganism. History shows that the teachings of Catholic Church fathers Clement of Alexandria, Origen and others gradually turned most Christians from the belief in a literal 1,000-year reign of Christ on earth to immortality in heaven or hell. Dante's writings of the 12th century added to the illusion of this error.

Hellenistic philosophy, which had borrowed heavily from ancient Egyptian mythology, began to be taught instead of the teachings of the Bible as the source of doctrine! Prevailing concepts such as the immortality of the soul, an ever-burning hell, purgatory and heaven all came directly out of ancient mythology! The popular church, to become more acceptable to potential pagan converts, adopted and taught these pagan philosophies rather than the plain teachings of the Bible! Today, the idea of heaven being the "reward of the saved" is nearly universal among mainstream Christian churches.

Unfortunately, modern Judaism, which was started with Rabbi Akiva in the second century AD, also inherited much mysticism and occultic teachings and also believe today in reincarnation and the immortality of the soul.

The bible is very clear in Ezekiel 18:4, " *The soul that sins it shall die".*

The promise to the unrepentant sinner in the judgment day is death, not eternal life in torment.

Also, look at the following scriptures; **<u>Rom 6:23</u>** For *the wages of sin is death*, but the gift of Yahweh *is* everlasting life in Yahshua Messiah our Master.

Ja 1: 14 But each one is tempted by his own lusts, he covets and is seduced by them.

15 Then having conceived lust brings forth sin. <u>And sin being fully formed brings</u> <u>forth death.</u>

In addition Mathew the tenth chapter is extremely clear on if the soul is immortal.

Math 10: 28 And you should not fear the ones killing the body, but not being able to kill the soul. But rather fear Him being able to <u>destroy both soul and</u> <u>body in Gehenna.</u>

Clearly, the biblical teaching is that the soul is not immortal and can be destroyed in the Lake of fire on judgment day for the incorrigible wicked.

Degeneration or Regeneration?

Someone has said that "one generation is a generation away from regeneration." I have seen this happen in my lifetime.

As a child growing up in our little town it was the shock of the town if someone got involved in adultery. This was not only the sentiment of church folk but of everyone in town. Now, hardly anyone bats an eyelid when this happens in the body of Messiah! Is this not degeneration?

When I was a child, believers did not go to the movie theater. When my mother died at 83 years of age she had never been in a movie theater.

One time, when I was an adult, I said to my mother, "Mum, there are some good movies that you could perhaps watch without being defiled."

"Oh no," she replied, "What if the Master was to come and find me in the movie theater!"

Now, it seems the norm for Believers to go to nearly every movie that comes to town. And if they don't do that, they watch them in the privacy of their homes! I am not saying that we cannot watch a wholesome movie, but we certainly must use discernment and scrutiny.

When I was a child we hadn't even heard of the word 'pornography'. It was never mentioned. Now, it is a word that is part of every day language and a bondage that has gripped thousands of men in the church today. What degeneration!

We know that there have always been backyard abortions, but when we were children we never heard the word spoken aloud. It wasn't practiced in the

congregations. Now many church-going women have abortions!

Although pagan societies have always accepted abortion, it was an antipathy in

the early church. The influence of Christianity in this respect began with the very earliest stage of human life... With unwavering consistency and with the strongest

emphasis; they denounced the practice, not simply as inhuman, but as definitely murder." We have degenerated greatly. I believe it is time we got some backbone back into the church and into society. Why do YHWH's people surrender to the climate of society and take that for their standard rather than the eternal Word of Elohim? Have we become "cream puffs" or "jelly fish" as my husband often says?

How do we get back to Elohim's ways? David cried out in Psalm 11:3, "If the foundations be destroyed, what can the righteous do?" I believe we have to build the foundations again. How do we do this? It starts with us parents. We are responsible to pass on the baton of Yahweh's truth and standards to the next generation. If we fail to do this, we fail Yahweh and this generation. It is Yahweh's plan that each generation of parents pass on His ways to the next generation, establishing holy generations in the earth. It's no use sending our children to church or telling them what to do if they do not see it operating in our lives. They will follow who we are and what we do. They see through any compromise and hypocrisy. Perhaps you are struggling to fight the good fight of faith? Don't give up. Keep standing your ground. We must also impart to our children the ability to fight and contend for the faith. We are the example for them to follow. Evil is becoming more rampant. But Elohim has told us in Isaiah 60:1-2 to arise and shine in the dark times. Will we shine in this evil day? Or will we hide our light and succumb to the darkness?

Eph 5:11 "And have no fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness, but rather condemn them."

May Elohim save us from getting so used to the climate we live in that we think it is normal. May He open our eyes to see His standards, and hold on to them. May He save us from assimilation, the most subtle of the enemy's strategies. May He anoint us to expose the evil around us.

Everything today has to be politically correct. In other words, we have to fit into what the world is doing! This is not the Bible. This is apathy. It is being lukewarm which makes YHWH sick. We don't have to be politically correct. We must be Biblically correct, even if we face persecution.

Most Believers do not condone adultery, abortion and homosexuality. They would never do these things themselves. But they don't want to make a scene. I hear many saying, "Well, I wouldn't do that, but that is their personal choice. If that's what they want to do, I have to accept it." And now, these things have become acceptable!

All because we did not take a stand! We did not fight for Yahweh's truth! We assimilated to the popular trend! May Elohim help us to once again, be a holy people, filled with His truth and His Spirit, who will push back evil rather than yielding to it.



Do you Dress Like a King?

At our Bible school called Hayahad we have a motto called "Raising the Bar".

When you think that as a first fruit unto Yahweh and a begotten child in His family, that we are maybe 1 out of 100 million people on this earth, don't you think that we have a responsibility to set an example to the world around us?

Even more than that, as a first fruit unto Yahweh and a begotten child in His family "don't you think we have a responsibility according to scripture to stay separated from the ways of the world?"

The answer to both questions is an astounding yes.

We are living in what the bible refers to as the last days. Scripture tells us that these days are the most immoral and spiritually degenerated than any other in the history of mankind. It compares these days to both the days of Noah, when Yahweh destroyed the whole inhabitable world and the days of Lot, when perversion was so illicit that homosexually was rampant and sexual perversion was the norm and not the exception.

This perversion did not come overnight, but has been ingrained into our nervous systems over a full generation until now, literally becoming a part of the mindset of society.

Probably less than 1% of people are virgins when they get married and almost 60% of marriages end up in divorce due to this evil indoctrination by Satan of an immoral, illicit society.

So when we are discussing proper dress to those who are called out of the world to be kings and priests in Yahweh's soon coming Kingdom, it goes much further than culture, as it truly comes down to are you exhibiting in your dress righteousness or worldliness?

<u>**1** Joh 2:15</u> Do not love the world nor the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him,

16 because all that which is in the world: the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world.

17 And the world is passing away, and its lust. But the one doing the will of Yahweh abides forever.

We are to be a light to a dark and dying world. We as leaders for the Kingdom of Yahweh are not to go along with every new perverted fashion, but we are to set the standard of modesty and holiness that our Savior set before us. When Yahshua walked this earth as a human being for 33 years, He exemplified in every form of His life what a true King and Ambassador should be like.

The Apostle Paul reiterates the example that Yahshua set in the New Testament as he is telling Timothy the guidelines for dress and behavior in the Congregation of YHWH.

<u>1 Tim 3:15</u> But if I delay, <u>that you may know how to behave in the house of</u> <u>Yahweh, which is the Congregation of the living Elohim</u>, the pillar and foundation of the truth.

<u>1 Tim 2: 9</u> So also the women to adorn themselves in proper clothing, with modesty and sensibleness, not with plaiting, or gold, or pearls, or expensive garments, 10 but what becomes women professing fear of Yahweh, through good works.

The Apostle Simon Peter also lays down the same directive.

<u>**1** Pe 4:17</u> Because the time has come to begin the judgment from the house of Elohim; and if firstly from us, what will be the end of the ones disobeying the good news of Yahweh?

<u>1 Pe 3:3</u> Let your beauty be not just the outward adorning of braiding the hair, and of wearing jewels of gold, or of putting on fine clothing;

<u>**1** Pe 3:4</u> but in the hidden person of the heart, in the incorruptible adornment of a gentle and quiet spirit, which is in the sight of Yahweh very precious.

It is in the spirit of the above scriptures that we have tried to set the proper standard of dress in our protocol in the Congregation of YHWH, Jerusalem. Men should have clean modest apparel and no short pants, less their nakedness be exposed as was told to the sons of Levi in their priesthood (Ex 20:26).

Ex 20: 26 And you shall not go up by steps to My altar, <u>that your nakedness may not be</u> <u>uncovered on it</u>.

Yahweh had them build a ramp because according to Him, stepping on a step and having your ankle exposed is showing nakedness to YHWH.

Look at the example of dress by our Savior Yahshua when He returns.

<u>**Rev 1: 13**</u> And having turned, I saw seven golden menorahs, and in the midst of the seven menorahs <u>**One like the Son of Man, wearing a garment down to the feet**</u>, and having His breasts girded with a golden girdle.

In like manner, we ask that women would wear modest dresses or skirts below the knees, and that their dress should not be overly tight, to possibly cause lust to the men in the congregation. The entire focus shall be on Yahweh and not on the women trying to get the attention on themselves.

As a higher most spiritual priesthood of the order of Melchizedek we should strive in all things to be most holy and appropriately dressed when appearing before our Heavenly Father.

There are a few people who still have not completely come out of the world, who do not want any type of dress code in the congregation and they ask, where does it say in the Torah that a woman should not wear pants? But, I would also ask wear does it say in Torah that a believer should not smoke cigarettes, take drugs, or watch evil Hollywood movies?

The point is that the Torah is a lamp to my feet (Ps 119:105) and it is a guide that we need to use for every aspect of our life. We need to look at Torah and see what the spirit of the Torah is saying.

<u>Deu 22: 5</u> "Women are not to wear men's clothing, and men are not to wear women's clothing; YAHWEH your Elohim hates people who do such things.

Now I believe from this scripture that we can safely conclude that a woman should not wear pants. Some may ignorantly say that in Yahshua's day men even wore dresses. This is not an accurate statement as a man's garment in Yahshua's day was far from a dress and very masculine looking and I have actually studied remains of garments from archaeological research that clearly shows men and women 's garments were very different.

I was speaking to an older man a while back and he said to me that when he was younger in the Baptist church every woman without fail wore dresses, but you don't see that today. Clearly from as early as pants became a garment for humans, they were worn **BY MEN NOT WOMEN.**

When did women start to wear the pants in the family? Starting in the 1960's when the whole women's lib movement came in and totally perverted our society and our dear poor sisters. This is a fact and is where the statement "*she wears the pants in the family*" came from. Wearing the pants was a sign of masculine authority. (1Tim 2: 12) Women should not usurp the authority of a man.

Do you know that in most third world cultures, such as Africa, where the women's lib movement has not corroded their society that all women still wear dresses? As a matter of fact, I was told in Kenya that if Sister Petra came to Kenya wearing pants that the brethren would not even have listened to me.

Most women's pants are immodest as people can see the womanly shape of your body. Wearing pants is a product of the western Babylonian society that has produced the selfexistent, totally vain, self-centered women of America and the West. It really is a cultural issue; do women want to portray the culture of Babylon or Eden? The choice is each sister's to decide.

We as believers are working toward restoring all truth back to this earth in preparing for Yahshua's soon return. Do we want to just get by or do we want to raise the bar? Do we want to teach our children about Eden or do we want to teach them old habits of Babylon.

Yahweh made the natural femininity of a woman one of her greatest gifts to mankind. Yahweh made a natural beauty to a woman in the feminine style that she carries herself and Satan is trying to destroy this through vanity in the women's lib movement. <u>Jer 6:16</u> So says Yahweh, Stand by the ways and see, and ask for the old paths, where the good way is, and walk in it; and you shall find rest for your souls. But they said, We will not walk in it. We are not to judge by appearance, but if we are honest with ourselves we know that first impressions mean a lot, and we want to be a good witness by being modest and trying to be the best example of our beloved Savior Yahshua.

<u>**1** Cor 6: 19</u> Or do you not know that your body is a sanctuary of the Holy Spirit in you, which you have from Yahweh, and you are not of yourselves? 20 You were bought with a price; **then glorify Yahweh in your body**, and in your spirit, which belong to Yahweh.

Scripture clearly says that we are to glorify our Creator in our body and the way we dress. Is dressing like the world, immodestly, glorifying our Heavenly Father or being an image of the way Yahshua was when He was on this earth? The answer is clearly NO! In addition, how do we dress on the Sabbath when we appear before Yahweh and His Assembly? Are we well groomed with neat clean clothing? Are we wearing the best we have or are we simply showing up before the Creator of the Universe in ripped jeans and flip-flops?

Some will say, well this is all I can afford, but it does not cost any more money to present yourself in a clean well kept manner, then in a dirty unkempt state. It really is simply a matter of choice. Even in Africa where people are very poor, every man has one suit that he will wear every Sabbath to appear as dignified as possible before His Creator. People can buy good name brand clothes at Good Will stores or second hand shops for minimal finances. Some of my suits are more than 20 years old and they are still in very good condition; so we are not advocating a class system, which would be against scripture, but merely encouraging to be the best that we can be with the things that Yahweh has blessed us with.

If Yahshua returned tomorrow and you were told that He called for a meeting with you, how would you appear before Him? Remember the Sabbath is a rehearsal and it is a sign of respect to appear before our Maker as best and modest as we can.

<u>Math 22:11</u> And the king coming in to look over those reclining, **He saw a man there not** having been dressed in a wedding garment.

12 And He said to him, Friend, **how did you come in here, not having a wedding** garment? But he was speechless.

13 Then the King said to the servants, **Binding his feet and hands, take him away and** *throw him out into the outer darkness.* There shall be weeping and gnashing of the teeth. 14 For many are called, but few chosen.

As an Ambassador of Yahshua for His soon coming Kingdom, let us strive to raise the bar in every aspect of our life. Let us make every effort not only to be chosen, but also to be faithful. Let us realize that as a representative of Yahweh Almighty that we always want to exhibit the highest quality of honor, integrity, and truth in every thing that we do, including, how we dress and the perception that we give to others.

Yes, being a king does not just happen overnight; you have to work on it every day of your life and it should be exemplified in every manner of our life, including how we dress and how we look. First impressions do count, especially when you are the child of the King of the Universe.

Become an Ambassador for Israel



<u>2 Cor 5:20-</u> Then on behalf of Messiah, we are ambassadors, as Yahweh is exhorting through us
<u>Rev 5: 20-</u> and made us kings and priests to our Elohim; and we shall reign on the earth.

Apply for the Return to the land Program

Scripture clearly tells us that to be true believers we will be Kings and Priests of the Most High Elohim in His Kingdom and that we are now Ambassadors for Yahweh's soon coming Kingdom. To this end, we will teach and train our students how to prepare for this most important job. Ambassadors are not just sent, but they must be trained for the position and country that they are going to.

Feast of Sukkot (Tabernacles) 2010

It is truly one of the most exciting experiences that you will have in your life, to be blessed to spend a feast in Israel and take a Pilgrimage in the land. After reading the Holy Scriptures for so many years, to be able to see it all with your own eyes will be a life changing experience. We are trying to truly encourage representatives from countries all over the world to come and experience this rare blessing, and represent their given nation as **Zech 14:16** states. As it states in

<u>Eze 36:38</u> Like a holy flock, like the flock of Jerusalem in her appointed feasts, so the wasted cities shall be filled with flocks of men. And they shall know that I am Yahweh.

Before Sukkot you will arrive in the *Old City* and we will build our Sukkah before the opening night of the feast. Then, during Sukkot we will travel several days around the *Old City of Jerusalem* and you will get to see the *Mount of Olives*, *The City of David*, as well as *David's tomb* and the *room of the last supper*, and also the remains of the *House of Caiphas* where they still have today the remains of the scourging room where Yahshua would have been held the night before His crucifixion. We also hope to possibly go to the Israeli Knesset during Sukkot, as well as take you to a biblical park that will teach you everything there is to know from a Hebrew perspective on the harvest fruits of Sukkot and the land of Israel.

After Sukkot we will stop at the **Valley of Elah** where David fought Goliath, before stopping to visit **Beersheba** where Abraham made covenant with Yahweh and the well he dug with his own hands. Then we will go to the wilderness of **Kadesh Barnea** where you will get to experience life like the Israelites did when leaving Egypt. Then we will actually spend the night in Sinai and you will get to see **the original Red Sea crossing site, where Chariot wheels of Pharaohs army have been found.** The next day we will head back to Israel and see the **Timna copper mines** where Solomon got the copper for the Temple, and from there will stop at **the Dead Sea**.

The next day you will get to see sunrise at *Masada, Qumran, and the Cave of the Columns*, where the famous copper scroll spoke about, then go through the Jordan Valley to *Bet Shean*.

The next day we will travel in the north and you will be blessed to see **Nazareth** the very village where Yahshua grew up. Then we will go to *Gideon's spring*, where he chose his army by the way the men drank the water, as well as The *Jezreel valley* where Ahab's Palace was and ride through the beautiful landscape of *Mount Gilboa*. Afterward we will go by Kursi where Yahshua cast the demons into the pigs, and Capernaum where He spent most of His ministry in the north and will end the day taking *a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee*, the very water that Yahshua walked on.
