Transcription – Learning the 7 Mentalities of the Eagle – Elder Vincent

Chag Semeach! And welcome to Sabbath. Yahweh is great Master of Congregation, Last Great Day. Today's message is, Learning the 7 Mentalities of the Eagle.

So, we know that Yahshua is Lion of the tribe of Judah who comes back a second time. He is the Lamb of Yah. And like a dove, He is meek. Yahweh, the Father, always compares Himself and His people in one specific animal; which is the eagle. And if we go to Exodus 19 through 4:

Exodus 19:1-4 In the third month of going out of the sons of Israel from the land of Egypt, from this day they came to the wilderness of Sinai. And they pulled up stakes from Rephidim and came to the wilderness of Sinai. And they camped in the wilderness. And Israel camped there before the mountain. And Mosheh went up to Elohim. And YAHWEH called to him from the mountain, saying, You shall say this to the house of Jacob, to tell it to the sons of Israel. You have seen what I did to Egypt; that I bore you on eagle's wings and brought you to Me.

And Deuteronomy 32 beginning 9:

Deuteronomy 32:9-13 For the portion of YAHWEH is His people; Jacob is the lot of His inheritance. And found him in a desert land, and in the waste, a howling wilderness. He encircled him and cared for him; He guarded him as the pupil of His eye. As the eagle stirs up its nest; it hovers over its young; and spreads out its wings and takes it, and bears it on its wings. YAHWEH alone led him, and there was no strange god with him. He made him ride on the high places of the earth, so that he might eat the increase of the fields. And He made him suck honey out of the rock, and oil out of the flinty rock;

So that rock there is Sela. And in Revelation 12:14 says:

Revelation 12:14 And two wings of a great eagle were given to a woman, that she might fly into the wilderness, to her place, where she is nourished there for a time, and times, and half a time, away from the serpent's face.

So here you seven mentalities that we can learn from the eagle; the first one is:

The Eagles fly alone. So eagles don't fly with sparrows, ravens and other small birds. So the Scripture tells us that:

(Proverbs 27:17) Iron sharpens iron ... in Proverbs ... so man sharpens his friends face.

And also in Corinthians 15, **1**st **Corinthians 15:33**, you will be like the people who you associate with. And also in Proverbs 13:20:

Proverbs 13:20 He who walks with the wise shall be wise, but a companion of fools shall be broken.

So, that is also there a message of Paul in 2nd Corinthians 6 that ... maybe we'll read it ... 2nd Corinthians 6 ... 2nd Corinthians 6:14 to 18:

2nd Corinthians 6:14-16 Do not unite in marriage with unbelievers. For what partnership does righteousness have with the lawlessness? And what fellowship does light have with darkness? And what agreement does the Messiah have with Satan? Or what part does a believer have with an unbeliever? And what harmony has the sanctuary of Elohim with idols? For you are the sanctuary of the living Elohim, even as He said, "I will dwell in them and walk among them, and I will be their Elohim, and they shall be My people.

2nd Corinthians 6:17-18 Because of this, "Come out from among them and be separated, says YAHWEH, and do not touch the unclean thing, and I will receive you." "And I will be a Father to you, and you will be sons and daughters to Me, says YAHWEH Almighty."

So, just like the previous messages from Elder Wilco, it's coming out of the world's system. That is the first mentality – number one. And the number two:

Eagles have vision. In Proverbs 29:18 it says:

Proverbs 29:18 Where there is no vision, the people are unrestrained. But blessed is he, the one keeping the Torah of YAHWEH.

It says in **Deuteronomy 32** that the Torah is not a useless word, but it is our life. So, the eagle they have the ability to focus on something as far as five kilometers away. No matter what the obstacles the eagle will not move his focus from the prey until he grabs it.

And praise Yahweh in this Congregation, we can see that vision from Yahweh that what is happening today, Yahweh already prepared us a long, long time ago. And because of the Shemita, because of Yahweh's Torah we are able to prepare for what is happening.

And we are blessed at that. I personally, I am blessed that I am part of this Congregation because if I am the other group, I don't believe that I have eyes to see and ears to hear ... so praise Yahweh that we have it; the vision, and Yahweh is leading us. And also we know that whatever ... we heard that so many, many times ago: whatever the focus on, what is our focus is becomes most real to us. And our focus is the Kingdom of Yahweh.

And number three:

Eagles are fearless. And an eagle will never surrender to the size or strength of its prey. It will always give a fight to win it's prey or regain its territory. It means no matter what the size or how big your challenges or problem or trials, don't give up. Instead face it because successful people are fearless. They face problems head on.

And also again, we read a lot of times in the Scripture, Yahweh told His people from Abraham, from Isaac, from Joseph, from Mosheh to Joshua, we always hear Yahweh commanding them, "Do not fear." And also we know in **1**st **John 4:16** that fear of false evidence appearing real is not of Yahweh; it's satans.

So, if we can read 1st John 4 ... 1st John 4:16:

1st John 4:16-17 And we have known and have believed the love which Elohim has in us. YAHWEH is love, and the one abiding in love abides in Elohim and Elohim in him. By this, love has been perfected with us, that **we have confidence in day of judgment** ... and wow, the White Throne Judgement, the Last Great Day ... and that as He is, we are also in this world.

1st **John 4:18-21** There is no fear in love, but perfect love casts out fear, because fear has torment; and the one fearing has not been perfected in love. **We love Him because He first loved us**. If anyone says, I love Elohim, and hates his brother, he is a liar. For the one not loving his brother whom he has seen, how is he able to love YAHWEH whom he has not seen? And we have this commandment from Him, that he who loves Elohim ought to also love his brother.

And we know in Genesis, in **Genesis 15**, in **Genesis through 46**, **Deuteronomy 1 to Deuteronomy 13**, we always see the commandment of Yahweh, the command of Yahweh to His people, **do not fear**. If we go to Psalm 56 ... Psalm 56:11, it's David:

Psalm 56:11 In Elohim I have trusted; I will not fear; what will man do to me?

So, we just trust in Yahweh and we don't have to fear anything, especially anything in this world. Jump to Isaiah 44:2:

Isaiah 44:2 So says YAHWEH, who made you and formed you from the womb. He helps you. **Do not fear**, My servant Jacob; and you, Jeshurun whom I have chosen.

Isaiah 51:7, the same thing ...

Isaiah 51:7 Hear Me, those knowing righteousness, the people of My Torah in their heart; ... the people of My Torah in their heart ... do not fear the reproach of man, and do not be bowed from their blaspheming.

In Jeremiah 30, beginning in 10:

Jeremiah 30:10-11 And you, O My servant Jacob, **do not fear**, says YAHWEH. Do not be terrified, O Israel. For, lo, I will **save you from afar**, and your seed from the land of their captivity. And Jacob shall return, and have quiet, and be untroubled, and no one will make him afraid. For I am with you, says YAHWEH, **to save you**. Though I make a full end among all nations where I have scattered you, yet I will not make a full end with you. But I will correct you justly, and I will not leave you unpunished.

So, we know that's Yahweh's commandment. It's Yahweh's commandment we should, we must do it; not fearing. So we need to be fearless in everything in this world. But we need the fear of Yahweh. That's the only fear we have.

In Proverbs 2:5 says:

Proverbs 2:5 then you shall understand the fear of YAHWEH and find knowledge of Elohim.

In Proverbs 3, just the next chapter:

Proverbs 3:7 Do not be wise in your own eyes; **fear YAHWEH** and depart from evil.

In Proverbs 23:7 ... I mean 17 ... 23:17:

Proverbs 23:17 Do not let your heart envy sinners but only be in the fear of YAHWEH all the day.

So we know in the seven gateways to enter Yahweh's Kingdom, the number one there is the fear of Yahweh and the respect of authority. So again, **we need to be fearless in obeying Yahweh**. Once you understand that all that you are doing is you are obeying Yahweh, do not fear. And that is the commandment of Yahweh from the very beginning from His ancient people; from Abraham until today, to us. So, we need to trust in Yahweh that He can do everything. Nothing is impossible with Yahweh.

And number four of the eagle's mentality is:

The eagles are tenacious. Eagles love storm. When clouds gather, the eagles get excited. The eagles use the storm wind to lift themselves higher. Once it finds the wind of the storm, the eagles use the raging storm to lift above the clouds. This gives the eagle an opportunity to glide and rest its wings. In the meantime, all the other birds hide in the branches and leaves, and the leaves of the tree.

So, we know that **achievers are not afraid of challenges**. Rather they relish them and use them for greater ability. And we need to have that mindset of **Exodus 14:14** in every situation, in every testing of Yahweh that He is giving as challenges. So we need the mentality of – Yahweh will fight for us and we should be silent.

So we can go to Lamentations 3:25:

Lamentations 3:25-26 YAHWEH is good to those waiting on Him, to the soul seeking Him. It is good that a man hopes for the salvation (Y'shua*) of YAHWEH, even in silence.

So **Exodus 14:14** the same thing ... that Yahweh will fight for us and we should be in silence. And even in 1st Peter 1:5-7 ... 1st Peter 1:5-7:

1st Peter 1:5-7 While you were kept by the power of Elohim, being guarded through faith to a salvation ready to be revealed in the last time; wherein you will rejoice forever, not withstanding, at the present time you are pressed a little, by the various trials that have come upon you; so that the **proving** of your faith, much more **precious** than perishing gold, but having been proved through fire, ... just like the latest message that we are clay. We are a Potter's clay ... and may be made manifest to praise and honor and glory at the revelation of Yahshua Messiah;

So that's why we need to have that mentality that if challenges is present in our life, we should be honoring Yahweh more because Yahweh honored us to be there just like Yahshua ... "Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani, why have you honored me? You have honored me to be here."

So that's the fourth, and the fifth is:

Eagles never eat dead things. Of course, we have the lesson 23. We have Leviticus 11 and also the Torah that we read yesterday that tells us in **Deuteronomy 14:6** that we should not eat dead things; or the things that died itself. But of course, there is also a spiritual understanding in this that we need to be **sanctified**. We need to be kadosh.

In 2nd Corinthians 6:17 says:

2nd Corinthians 6:17-18 Because of this, "Come out from among them and be separated, says YAHWEH, and do not touch the unclean thing, and I will receive you." "And I will be a Father to you, and you will be sons and daughters to Me, says YAHWEH Almighty."

1st Corinthians 6:19-20 Or do you not know that your body is a sanctuary of the Holy Spirit in you, which you have from Elohim, and you are not of yourselves? You were bought with a price; then glorify Elohim in your body, and in your spirit, which belongs to Elohim.

2nd Corinthians 7:1 Then having these promises, beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all defilement of flesh of the spirit, perfecting holiness **in the fear of Elohim**.

So, the eagles never eat dead meat. In other words, the eagle does not scavenge; it only eats from the prey it kills itself. It also means that **we don't need to rely on our past; whether success or failure**. So keeping looking for new frontiers to conquer, to overcome; leave your past where it belongs in the past.

And if we go in Isaiah 43 ... Isaiah 43:18:

Isaiah 43:18-19 Do not remember former things, nor consider the things of old. Behold, I will do a new thing; now it shall sprout. Shall you not know it? **I will even make a way in the wilderness**, rivers in the desert.

Isaiah 43:20-21 The beast of the field shall honor Me, jackals and daughters of ostriches; because I give waters in the wilderness, rivers in the desert, to give drink to **My people, My chosen**. The people that I formed for Myself and shall recount My praise.

So also, in 2nd Corinthians 5 ... 2nd Corinthians 5:17 ... *For we are not as many pedaling the Word of Elohim but according* ... 5:17, sorry ... 2nd Corinthians 5:17:

2nd Corinthians 5:17-19 So that if anyone is in Messiah, he is a **new creation**; the old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new! And all things are from Elohim, the One having reconciled us to Himself through Yahshua Messiah, and having given to us a ministry of reconciliation, for YAHWEH was in Messiah who has reconciled the world with His majesty, not charging their sins against them, and has committed to us the Word of reconciliation.

2nd Corinthians 5:20 -21 Then on behalf of Messiah, **we are ambassadors**, as Elohim is exhorting through us, we beseech on behalf of Messiah, be reconciled to YAHWEH. For He who did not know sin, for your sake made Himself sin, that we might through Him become the righteousness of YAHWEH.

So we need to be looking for that - new frontiers to overcome. And that is Yahweh's way also. With a new heavens and new earth, New Jerusalem, with His new covenant. So, that's the fifth mentality that you can have from the eagle.

And sixth is:

Training. Eagles always prepare for training. They remove the feather and the soft grass in the nest so that the young ones get uncomfortable in preparation for flying and eventually they fly when it becomes too unbearable to stay in their nest.

So, it means **leave your comfort zone because there is no growth there**. So, this is the perfect place – the wilderness; the perfect place that Yahweh chose for us. Deuteronomy 8:2:

Deuteronomy 8:2 And you shall remember all **the way** which YAHWEH your Elohim has caused you to go these forty years in the wilderness, **in order to humble you, to try you, to know that which is in your heart**, whether you will keep His commandments or not.

So this is the perfect place Yahweh chose for training. In Psalm 95:8 ... in Psalm 95:8:

Psalm 95:8 do not harden your heart as in the day of strife, as in the day of **testing in the wilderness**.

So, eagles always prepare for training. And the last one:

Eagles possess vitality. When the eagle grows old his feather becomes weak and cannot take him as fast, as high as it should. This makes him weak and could make him die. So they retire to a place from far away in the mountains. And while there he plucks out the weak feathers on his body. It breaks its beaks and his claws against the rocks until it is completely bear; a very bloody and painful process.

Then he stays in his hiding place until he has grown new feathers, new beaks and new claws. And then comes out flying higher than ever before. It means we need to shed of old habits, no matter how difficult things that burden us or add no value to our lives as true believers. Yahshua actually commanded us not to be anxious in **Matthew 6:25**.

And also, we got to get rid of old habits; and that old habit is the habit of the **old you**, old me because we are a new creation of Yahweh. So, if we go to Romans 12:2 ... Romans 12:2. It's very timely, it says ... beginning 1:

Romans 12:1-2 Therefore, brethren, I call on you through the compassions of Elohim to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, **holy**, pleasing to Elohim, which is your reasonable service. And **be not conformed** to this age, but be transformed by the **renewing of your mind**, in order to prove by you what is good and pleasing and perfect will of Elohim.

So we need to change that old mentality, old mindset. And praise Yahweh, we have our training. We have seven habits to become one of the 144,000; which is: number one: being proactive; number two: begin plan with El in mind; number three: must have priority; number four: always think win/win; number five: looking to understand before being understood.

And this one it really helps me. Yeah, I'm always looking to monitor in myself that I am practicing this – looking to understand before being understood; synergistic and sharpening or brainstorming.

And last seven gateways to enter Yahweh's Kingdom; and number one is: *The Fear of Yahweh and the Respect for Authority*; number two: *True Repentance*; *Humble and Contrite Spirit*, number three. Number four: *By Your Patience You Will Gain Your Soul*; number five: *Perseverance*. Number six: *Judicial Order* and number seven is the: *True Worship*.

And that's it, the seven examples; the seven mentalities of the eagle. And the last verse ... the last book I will read is Isaiah 40 ... Isaiah 40 beginning verse 10:

Isaiah 40:10-13 Behold, Adonai YAHWEH will come with strength, and His arm rules for Him ... that is Yahshua ... Behold, His reward is with Him, and His wage before Him. He shall feed His flock like a shepherd; ... like a shepherd mentality. We learned it last time ... He shall gather lambs with His arm; and carry them in His bosom; those with young He will lead; who has measured in His hand the waters and the heavens by a span meted out; and enclosed in the measure the dust of the earth, ... we are clay, the dust of the earth ... and weighed in the balance the mountains, and the hills the scales, who has meted out the Spirit of YAHWEH, or a man His counsel taught Him?

Isaiah 40:14-17 With whom did He take counsel, who trained Him and taught Him in the path of justice; and taught Him knowledge, and made known to Him the way of discernment? Lo, nations are as a drop from a bucket, and are reckoned as dust of the scales. Lo, He takes up coasts as a little thing. And Lebanon is not enough to burn, nor are its beasts enough for a burnt offering. All the nations are as nothing before Him; to Him they are reckoned less than nothing and emptiness.

Isaiah 40:18-21 And to whom will you liken El? Or what likeness will you array to Him? A craftsman pours out the casted image, the smelter spreads it with gold; and he casts the chains of silver. He too poor for that offering chooses a tree that will not rot; he seeks a skilled artisan for him, to prepare a carved image that will not be shaken. Have you not known? Have you not heard? Was it not told to you from the beginning? Did you not discern from the foundations of the earth?

Isaiah 40:22-25 He who sits on the circle of the earth, even those living in it are like grasshoppers; He who stretches the heavens like curtains, and spreads them like a tent to live in; who brings princes into nothing. He makes judges of the earth as nothing. Yea, they shall not be planted; yea, they are not sown; yea, their stem is not taking root in the earth. And He shall also blow on them, and they shall wither, and the whirlwind shall lift them up like stubble and take them away. To whom then will you compare Me, or I am equaled, says the Holy One?

Isaiah 40:26-28 Lift up your eyes on high and look: Who has created these? Who brings out their host by number? By greatness of vigor, and might of power, He calls them all by names; not one is lacking. Why will you say, O Jacob, and speak, O Israel; why My way is hidden from YAHWEH, and my judgment is passed over by my Elohim? Have you not

known? Have you not heard? YAHWEH, the everlasting Elohim, the Creator of the ends of the earth; He is not faint, nor does He grow weary; there is no searching to His understanding.

Isaiah 40:29-31 He gives power to the faint, and to him with no vigor He increases might. Even youths are faint and fatigued, and young men stumbling shall stumble; but the ones waiting for YAHWEH shall renew power; they shall go up with wings as the eagles; they shall run and not be weary; they shall walk and not be faint!

So that's the message and Chag Semach!
