

Transcript – Yahweh’s Justice

Alrighty, Chag Semach again! And I pray that everybody has had a blessed feast as we have, especially in the days we're living in, the times ahead. And it's like the holy days are always kind of like Yahweh putting protection around His people during the worst times. And always trouble always seems to happen around the holy days, particularly in Israel. We've seen that for many, many years.

So the seventh day of the feast here, I'd like to give a message today called, *Yahweh’s Justice*. And it's really fitting. I didn't, of course, as I'm putting this together a while ago, I didn't know there'd be war and all this other stuff going on. I plan to do this for the seventh day, but here we are, and I think this message really, really fits in for currently what's happening in the world today.

So I want to start John 18, verse 33 through 40. And it says ... this is when Yahshua is before Pilate:

John 18:33-35 *Then Pilate again went into the praetorium and called Yahshua, and said to Him, Are You the King of the Jews? Yahshua answered him, Do you say this from your heart, or did others tell you about Me? Pilate answered, am I a Jew? Your nation, even the chief priests, delivered You up to me! What did You do?*

John 18:36-37 *Yahshua answered, My kingdom is not of this world. If My kingdom were of this world, My servants would have fought that I might not be delivered up to the Jews. But now My kingdom is not from here. Then Pilate said to Him, Are You really a king? Yahshua answered, You say that I am a king. For this purpose I have been born, and for this I have come into the world, that I might witness to the Truth. Everyone being of the Truth hears My voice.*

John 18:38 *Pilate said to Him, **What is truth?** ... It's no truth in Satan’s system, right? ... And saying this, he again went out to the Jews and said to them, I do not find even one crime in Him!*

Comments: So why is he saying, “What is truth?” Because he sees it! He sees that the Jews are bringing Yahshua there just through envy, right? They know who He is, as we're going to see here in a minute, and they're doing it just to keep their own position. They're totally lying, obstructing justice. And Pilate, who isn't necessarily a righteous person by any means, he's seeing this and saying, “What is truth?”

And wow, do we see the same today? Everything you see in the news, everything you see from government officials everything that's said. It's the same thing, what is truth? Everything is manipulated, everything is lied about. And here we are, 2,000 years later, same situation.

John 18:38-39 *Pilate said to Him, What is truth? And saying this, he again went out to the Jews and said to them, I do not find even one crime in Him! But there is a common custom to you that I should release one prisoner to you at the Passover. Then you decide: should I release the King of the Jews to you?*

Comment: So should you release the person who did nothing wrong and actually was just helping people and healing people for His whole life? But look what they said,

John 18:40 *Then all cried out again, saying, Not this One, but Barabbas! But Barabbas was a robber.*

And it's kind of interesting, unless you understand the Aramaic, you wouldn't understand that **Bar-Abbas**, it's an Aramaic word, an Aramaic name, which means *son of the father*, right? And it's actually the interesting part was his first name was Yeshua.

So you have Yeshua, the son of the father, who is an insurrectionist, a murderer and a robber, and you have the real **Yahshua**, the Son of Yahweh, who is the true King of the universe and the Creator of the world and has only done good; never even one sin in His life, never mind a bad thought, anything. And that's the one that they want murdered and they want Barabbas.

So wow, what is truth in Satan's system, right? So they had the Creator of the world in front of them. Can you imagine **the Creator**? And I always say can you imagine just being five minutes with Yahshua? The One who has no beginning, no end - created everything the Bible says ... just five minutes alone with Him, talking to Him. And they had him there enough of five minutes, but for 32, 33 years, and they chose a murderer and a thief.

Luke 23, let's see a little more of this story in Luke. Like I said, all of the synoptic good news messages complement each other, and one might have a little bit more to a story than another, but none of them contradict each other. And in Luke here, 23:13, through 25, and it says,

Luke 23:13-14 *And having called together the chief priests and the rulers and the people, Pilate said to them, You brought this Man to me as perverting the people ... talking about Yahshua ... And, behold, examining Him before you, I found nothing blamable in this Man regarding that which you charge against Him.*

Comment: So Pilate's the governor, right? Like he said to Yahshua, "Don't you know, I have authority to let you go and I have authority to crucify you?" But apparently he didn't use his authority. Why? Because of the crowd, because of **his own fear** of what's happening with people. The same we see today. Do politicians make decisions based on what's right? No way on earth! They make decisions **what's best for them**.

Luke 23:15-19 *But neither did Herod, for I sent you up to him; and, behold, nothing worthy of death is done by Him. Therefore chastising Him, I will release Him ... It's like, yeah, let's beat Him a little bit, make you happy and then we'll release Him ... And he had to release to them one at the Feast ... it was a custom that they had. That one prisoner would be shown mercy and let go ... And they all together shouted, saying, Take this one, and release Barabbas to us (he who was thrown into prison due to some revolt and murder occurring in the city.)*

Comment: So where Yahshua was not looking for revolt, He was looking to take the Kingdom of Yahweh by changing our hearts. Like He told the apostles that if you have enemies and you show love to your enemy, he's not your enemy anymore. And if you do this person by person, sooner or later, there'll be no enemies anymore.

Luke 23:20-24 *Then Pilate again called out, desiring to release Yahshua. But they shouted, saying, Crucify! Crucify Him! And a third time he said to them, For what evil did this One do? I found no cause of death in Him. Therefore, chastising Him, I will release Him. But with loud voices they insisted, asking for Him to be crucified. And their voices, and that of the chief priests, prevailed. And Pilate commanded their request to be granted.*

Comment: And we're going to see from the next scripture how evil this is because not only did they **insist** that they want Yahshua to be killed because they wanted to hold their own position, but *they knew* who He was, which even makes it more evil.

Luke 23:25 *And he released to them the one thrown into prison due to revolt and murder, whom they asked. But he delivered Yahshua to their will.*

Wow. So we see this and another thing is kind of interesting. Like I said, because Pilate, if he really had any sort of righteousness in him. He was the governor. He had ... like he said to Yahshua, he had the authority. Did he use it? No. No. Because that's what politicians do. And unfortunately many people in authority, pastors, priests, **they all do what's best for them**. And that is not Yahweh's justice. That's the justice, the un-justest, that you have in commercial Babylon and Satan's system.

Look back to verse 12. And it says,

Luke 23:12 *And on that same day, both Pilate and Herod became friends with each other, for before they were at enmity between themselves.*

So why were they at enmity between each other? Because they both feared each other; because they both had a point of authority and they feared each other was going to hurt the other one. But evil loves evil, right? And here's the day where they're destroying Yahshua, the only thing that was good and what do they do? They become friends, right? So evil loves evil.

And like I say, don't look for justice in the system of Satan. And it's ironic that that's what people will say, that our human nature ... and humans are evil all the way through. Every human being is and they'll self-righteously make these claims, "Well, if Elohim really is real, why does He allow this and why does He allow that?" Because mankind was under the Garden of Eden, mankind was under the influence of Yahweh's justice and mankind rejected that in the Garden of Eden. And 6,000 years later, mankind rejects it every single day.

So here it is the person that's saying Yahweh doesn't exist and then they're blaming Yahweh for the evil in the world; it comes by mankind making these choices on their own. So it's pathetic, it's self-righteous, but **don't look for justice in Satan's system** because you're not going to get it. Actually be happy when you only get *some injustice* because as we see here, there's no end to Satan's injustice. There's no end to it.

So don't look for justice in Satan's system. Don't look for it. That's not our job. Our job is not to bring justice to Satan's system. Like in Babylon today, right? I feel bad because some of these people are good people and they're in positions of authority and they might be radio announcers or whatever. And they're all saying, they want to take the country back, they want to take the country back. There's nothing to take back, right? If you're a real believer, we're not trying to take back. We're trying to look forward to the Kingdom of Yahweh.

And you're never going to find justice in Satan's system. So don't look for it. That's not our message. Our message is not to bring justice to the system of Satan. **Our message is how much injustice is in that system and that there's something better**. You don't have to stay in that system. I'm not part of commercial Babylon. So I don't need Satan's justice. I have the justice of Yahweh.

So the Pharisees knew who Yahshua was, right? They knew He was from Yahweh, but they killed Him to keep their position. John chapter 3, verse 1 and 2, this proves this. John chapter 3:1 and 2, He says,

John 3:1-2 *But there was a man from the Pharisees, Nicodemus his name, a ruler of the Jews. This one came to Yahshua by night and said to Him, Rabbi, **we** ... who's we, the Pharisees and the Sadducees ... we know that You have come as a teacher from Elohim. For no one is able to do these miraculous signs which You do, except Elohim be with Him.*

So even when they were before Yahshua, they knew that. They knew that unless Yahweh was with Him, He couldn't heal the blind person. He couldn't heal a leper. He couldn't heal a cripple. He couldn't raise the dead. He certainly couldn't. He couldn't command the wind in nature unless Yahweh was with Him. **They knew it** and right here in Scripture **proves** that they knew it.

And what was their answer? You know what? If we don't do something, this guy is going to wind up taking our position. We have to kill him. And you see the same today. You see in politics, people run against each other right? And when they're running against each other, they're telling all the truth, "Hey, you know what this guy did? This guy did this and this guy did that."

Look at President Trump and Marco Rubio, the Secretary of State, now how they attacked each other, said all these bad things about each other, Ted Cruz, same thing. And then what happens? Once one wins, now we shake hands and we work with each other. Wow. What happened to all the bad things about this person? What happened to this person is a liar? What happened to all the things you said? How evil they were. They kind of forget about it because **that's Satan's system**, don't look for justice in Satan's system.

Satan's system is human beings doing what's best for them and they'll lie, they'll cheat and they'll steal just like we saw at Barabbas and just like we see today that you can't believe anything that comes out of their mouth. The reason why they do things like the war today that's going on in Iran, right? What did they say that this war was all about weapons of mass destruction? Didn't we hear that before with Saddam Hussein? Until we find out there were no weapons of mass destruction. And Iran, I'm not sticking up for them with their regime or anything else. All I'm saying is they were not ready with a nuclear bomb. That is an **absolute 100% lie** and every intelligence agency, including in America, says that.

But that was supposed to be the reason, but that's what I thought happened six months ago. I thought that's what happened. I thought that President Trump said, "They went in there and destroyed all their nuclear stuff. They brought them back to the Stone Age. They can't do it. It's all gone. A 100% is destroyed." So you don't build nuclear stuff in a matter of months. That takes 10 or 20 years to put nuclear stuff. They never had any capability of an ICBM missile to bring it anywhere.

Yet all of a sudden now, because they want to go and attack them again, what happens? Now you've got to make up any excuse. So you lie again. They were a week or two away from the bomb. But you know what? Go and do a search on the news and look. They've been saying that since 1985. You could find video of Benjamin Netanyahu who's since **1985** saying they're a week or two away from the bomb. Okay, here we are 40 years later, still no bomb.

That's Satan system and it's not even for the betterment of the people. Sometimes the whole government's got to lie to people to protect them. No they don't! And they don't lie to protect the people. They lie to protect themselves.

So, I hope anybody that hear this, especially new people, will understand - **never put any trusting human government** and that's why we don't vote because if I vote for these people, now I'm liable for the things they're doing if I vote for them. **My kingdom is not of this world.** That's what Yahshua said, right? And I am an ambassador for the Kingdom of Yahweh. So if I belong to the Kingdom of Yahweh, why would I vote in a foreign election?

The same way if you're an American, you're not voting in Canadian elections and if you're a Filipino, you're not voting in Thailand elections, if they even have elections, I don't know. But we are members of the Kingdom of Yahweh, right? So they knew who He was and here we are 2,000 years later and the same thing is happening.

Ezekiel 45:8-10 ... Ezekiel 45:8-10. This is about the coming justice that will be in Israel very soon. Not today. It's not there. It's not with their current government, but it will be there with the government of Yahshua. Ezekiel 45, verse 8,

Ezekiel 45:8-10 *It shall be for a land to him, for a possession in Israel, and My rulers shall not oppress My people any more. And they shall give the land to the house of Israel according to their tribes. So says Adonai YAHWEH: Enough for you, O rulers of Israel! Turn away violence and oppression, and **do justice and righteousness.** Lift away your acts of violence from My people, declares Adonai YAHWEH. Just balances and a just ephah, and a just bath, let there be to you.*

Equal balances are what they're supposed to be and that is not in Israel today. And it's never been there. In 1945 when Israel, or 1948 when Israel became a modern nation, the Torah was not their constitution. It was trying to be a democracy. Many of the people that started Israel were atheists. They didn't even believe in anything.

The whole Kibbutz movement, I say this when we would teach Kibbutz, in Israel when they came in 1910 and started Kibbutz and it was youth that came. It wasn't adults, it was youth and it had nothing to do with Torah and it had nothing to do religiously. It was about youth coming from Russia and all these different areas that wanted to come and work the land. That's how the movement started.

So today by far, you are not getting justice by Israel and the government that is in there today under Prime Minister Netanyahu is a very ... not a very good government whatsoever and they are lying to the people. It started a long time ago, but just look at COVID what they did.

If you look at where the green passports and all that stuff with COVID all came from, it came from Israel. Most of the technology that's coming for the mark of the beast is all being made in Israel. You go down to Beersheba and those areas, they call it, Little Silicon Valley because that's where all these starter companies are coming from. And it's being used in a very, very demonic fashion and unfortunately people don't understand it.

I remember different times talking to different Israelis that I just met, I didn't know that well, but you're just talking with them. They were all so much for all this, all for AI and all this stuff that's coming, not

understanding it. Not for evil reasons, just because that's business. And in Israel, wow, a lot of this stuff is really, really big.

But the government today there you're not going to find justice ... you're not going to find justice. And they lie to the people as much as President Trump and all other world leaders are lying to their people. It's just some leaders are a little bit better at it than other leaders, but they are liars. They are not looking for justice. They're looking for world government, right?

Satan is the g.o.d. of this world and his government is commercial Babylon, which is going to go down very soon. And then he will have global government that will be much worse. But that's the deception to the people. And unfortunately, the alternative is the great; the alternative is the Kingdom of Yahweh.

So when I say unfortunately, I mean, unfortunately that the people are not coming out of that system. That's the unfortunate part. But the fortunate part is **if you do** the Kingdom of Yahweh is waiting for all of us and we can live in that kingdom now because it's a *mental aspect* to live in it.

There'll be a real kingdom that's coming very soon. But as Yahweh's ambassadors, we need to mentally be living in that kingdom every day and not be living in commercial Babylon. It says come out of there. Come out of that system that's there now **and** the land, both of them.

Isaiah 59:7 through 9 ... Isaiah 59:7 through 9. He says,

Isaiah 59:7-9 *Their feet run to evil, and they hurry to pour out innocent blood. Thoughts of iniquity are their thoughts; wasting and ruin are in their ways. They do not know the way of peace; and no justice is in their tracks. They have made crooked paths for themselves; everyone going in them does not know peace. For this reason justice is far from us; and righteousness does not overtake us. We wait for light, but, behold, dimness; for brightness, but we walk in gloom.*

So before, there was always deception there. You look at the Oslo courts in the 1990s, what deception is there, right? And they're going to make peace with the Palestinians and Yasser Arafat is all of a sudden not a terrorist anymore and everything's going great. And you knew it wasn't true, but boy, where they had a lot of trickery in it and the way they made it *seem* like it was true.

Today, they don't even try to hide it. You see the Americans are negotiating with the Iranians and then as they're negotiating, they go and bomb them and they come out and say, "Ha, ha, ha. We really weren't negotiating a good faith" and they've done it more than once.

So how can you believe anything that's being said by anybody out there? And you really can't! And that's the internet. That's the internet world. If you want to believe that all eggs are white, go look on the internet, you can find out every single egg in the world is white. There is no other color of an egg but white. If you want to believe all eggs are brown, go on the internet looking, you'll find out every single last egg in the world is brown. There is no other color. And you can probably find out that eggs are black and green and yellow, maybe because it's Easter.

But that's the way it is. Anything that you want to find out ... and that's what I'm trying to tell people that before the way it was, the internet was monitoring what you're doing and they're pulling everything you're

doing and make a profile of you. But now it's past that point. Now they have a profile of everyone and they are creating that profile what they want you to be. So if they see that you want eggs to be black, they'll give you every article, every advertisement, they'll even sell you black eggs, buy it from us.

They'll give you whatever you want to hear, whatever lie you want to hear. And that's what Satan, he doesn't care what lie you believe as long as you believe a lie. And that's what he's doing with people. Drop down the verse 14 ... and that's why we need to come out of that system because justice is only in the Kingdom of Yahweh.

Isaiah 59:14 *And justice is driven back; ... Wow, is that an understatement? ... and righteousness stands far off; for truth stumbles in the plaza, and right is not able to enter. And the truth is lacking; and **whoever turns from evil makes himself a prey** ...*

Comments: And that is true, that is absolutely true. The way the internet is today, look, anyone who stands up for the truth, whether it's the COVID shot killed people; or today, it's if you're saying what's going on with the war, anything else. You are ostracized. They put bounties out on you. They'll put bounties, 5,000, 10,000 depending on how big what you're saying is true.

And they'll have all these influencers that are out there, get all this money, right? And just to give these messages to all of these suckers that are following their websites to say the same thing against somebody, right? And we see it. You see it with people like Tucker Carlson and whoever, whoever it's out there, as long as you're not following the narrative, that's what happens.

Isaiah 59:15 *And the truth is lacking; and **whoever turns from evil makes himself a prey** ... they have the resources in Satan's system of commercial Babylon and they will destroy anybody that they need to, to keep the truth from coming out ... And YAHWEH saw; and it was evil in His eyes, that there was no justice.*

Comment: It is evil. **This system is evil. What's going on today is evil.** It's absolutely evil. And the people of Yahweh should not be condoning it or should not be part of it. It's that simple. We should be the only ones ... because we're the only ones with the truth. We should be the ones coming out and speaking against this.

Isaiah 59:16 *And He saw that there was no man, and He was astonished that there was no intercessor. And **His own arm** ... the right arm of Yahweh ... **saved for Him; and His righteousness sustained Him.***

Comment: There is not going to be any human government that's going to change this, right? It is only going to be the Kingdom of Yahweh that comes to the earth. That's the only thing that's going to change this.

Isaiah 59:17 *For He put on righteousness like armor, and a helmet of Y'shua He put on His head. And He put on robes of vengeance as clothing; and He put on zeal like a mantle.*

Comment: When Yahshua is coming back, like I said, look out because He's got a sword in His hand and He's coming to destroy all this unrighteousness.

Isaiah 59:18 *According to works, so He will repay; fury to His foes; recompense to His foes; He will repay recompense to the coasts.*

Wow. This is what we have to look forward to. This is the righteousness that will be coming where justice is lacking. There is no good, no hope, only evil and darkness. That's why we don't want to be part of that.

When you look at things like 9-11, the towers coming down, and now they openly admit it that the government was in on it, that it was fake, almost everybody who's out there. And at the time, it was so evident that what they were saying, the narrative wasn't true. One of the so-called hijackers was rooming with a CIA agent. They knew what was going on. They let the thing happen and just to bring on that war and wow!

So, 9-11, 10-7, say the same thing. That was only 2023. As horrible as it was, how did that happen? We lived in Israel. We've been living 25 years in the Middle East there, for more than 20 years in Israel. And Israel is the most surveilled country in the world. A mouse can't come up to that fence without getting shot with a paint gun or something. It doesn't happen in Israel. There's no way in earth.

I've heard the recordings from soldiers being told to stand down. I've talked to people. We were there recently. I was talking with people in authority there that are investigating this. Nobody wants to admit that the government allowed it to happen, to bring on the next step of this global plan. But wow, they certainly had to know. There's no way in earth they couldn't have known.

So we see these things, even World War II now. They've known it for years and years and years, but now they admit it. It's written in the history books of the children that the Americans allowed the bomb to come on their land so that they can enter the war. They allowed Pearl Harbor to happen so that the US had a reason to enter the war.

This is what man does. **He justifies his evilness that it's for the greater good**, but it's not for the greater good. And like I said, it's all to protect themselves. And that's what happens. Human beings, as we see, will do anything to protect themselves. This whole Epstein thing that's going on that's what you're seeing. You're seeing lies and deception.

And a lot of this, even maybe this war in Iran, is indirectly connected to that because *people know* how evil they were and the things they did and they're trying to hide it from coming out. And people are being blackmailed. It is a fact.

So like I said, for 45 years, we've been here. Is Iran two weeks away from the bomb? Or aren't they? Going back to 1985 and they still don't have one. What's going on here? Are we being lied to or aren't we being lied to? And that's Satan's system. And Satan's system, don't look for justice.

And the goalposts will always change because what they start by saying, we're doing this for this. All of a sudden, comes next day, no, it's a whole different reason. First, "We're doing a regime change." And then "Oh, no, no, it's against nuclear weapons." And then, "Oh, no, no, we're doing it to help the people." It's always a different reason because when you lie, you have to give more lies to cover the first lies. And that's what a liar does.

But there's to the point where as people get older, like you look at President Trump now and he probably does have some mental capacities that are falling that you can't cover those lies anymore. And you actually lie in the

same sentence and you have nowhere to cover them. And you can't then rely on anything that that person can say.

And I say it's really interesting because when you look at Nebuchadnezzar, and I've said this since President Trump's first term, boy, does he fit the Nebuchadnezzar mold. Nebuchadnezzar did lose his mind and did have the long fingernails and was out eating grass for seven years. So he did lose his mind and we're seeing the same thing happening today with President Trump.

Psalm 89 verse 13 ... Psalm 89 in verse 13. But that's why we have been called to something so much greater than this. And we have to embrace the Kingdom of Yahweh. We have to embrace true justice and true righteousness. And that's the message we need to bring to people.

Because in this world, I just came from India also a really, really bad place what the government is doing to the people. But you can bring that message of hope that you can be part of a greater government. The government that's going to be around forever. It's not a temporary government. Every other government will come and go. But the Kingdom of Yahweh will last forever. Psalm 89 verse 13. He says,

Psalm 89:13-16 *You have a mighty arm; Your hand is strong, Your right hand is high ... Yahshua ... Justice and righteousness are Your throne's foundation; mercy and truth go before Your face. Blessed is the people knowing the joyful sound; O YAHWEH, they shall walk in the light of Your face. They shall rejoice in Your name always; ... is the name of Yahweh important? Of course ... and they are exalted in Your righteousness.*

So with Yahweh, all things happen. **Romans 8:28**, *those who love for the good and those who love Yahweh and have called according to purpose.* So when you're in covenant with Yahweh, you never have to worry. Look at Richard Wurmbrand, could you wind up in a concentration camp? Of course you can. But the flesh is going to die one way or the other, but the Spirit is going to live forever.

So anything that Yahweh allows, it's only to bring others to faith and it's only for His work to go on. And look at that great ministry that Richard Wurmbrand was able to start after World War II that still goes on today of helping persecuted believers and suffering believers around the world. So everything works for the good and we have to trust in Yahweh's righteousness.

Psalm 82 ... Psalm 82. It says:

Psalm 82:1-4 *Elohim stands in the company of the Almighty El; He judges in the midst of Elohim. Until when will you judge unjustly, and lift up the faces of the wicked? Selah. Vindicate the poor and fatherless; do justice to the afflicted and needy. Deliver the poor and needy; and save out of the hand of the wicked.*

Psalm 82:5-8 *They neither know nor will understand; they walk in darkness; all the foundations of the earth are shaken. I have said, You are Elohim, and all of you are sons of the Most High. But you shall die as men, and fall like one of the rulers. Rise, O Elohim, judge the earth; for You shall inherit in all the nations.*

Look at that. What He says, *I have said you are Elohim and sons of the Most High.* We have the Spirit of Yahweh in us if you have been baptized into His name and repented of your sins. And we are growing into **being Him**. We are being like Him. We are being part of His family. We are being sons and daughters.

And like He says, we will inherit the earth with Him. Yahshua is the King of all the earth and He is sharing that inheritance with us. And He will judge the earth in righteousness and we will be judging with Him. So we have to prepare for that and get ready right now. Only when Yahshua returns can the Kingdom of Yahweh bring true justice to the earth. Isaiah 9:6 and 7.

Isaiah 9:6-7 *For unto us a Child is born; to us a Son is given; and the government is on His shoulder; and His name is called Wonderful Counselor, The Mighty El, The Prince of Peace, The one who Fathered Everlasting life ... Yahshua is the Elohim. Of course He is. Look, is He going to be born a child? Of course He was. So we understand this ... There is no end to the increase of His government and of peace on the throne of David, and on His kingdom, to order it, and to sustain it with justice and with righteousness, from now and forever. **The zeal of YAHWEH of Hosts will do this.***

You better believe He will. Yes it will. It is coming. And praise Yahweh we are not in the beginning of the plan. We are not back with Adam and Eve in that garden 6,000 years ago. We are at the end of it. We are winding this thing down and knowing how close we are to that kingdom, every day of our life we should be preparing if we are really going to rule with Him.

Because He is not going to put somebody as the ... send you out to be the ruler of Pakistan or be the ruler of Egypt or whatever it is going to be where He is going to send you if you are not ready. You have to prepare for this. That is why *this training* that you are getting now should be the most important training of your life. That is basically what our Bible school has been about for 22 years. Training people to get rid of the things they need to get rid of now and to change.

But really that change is so they can rule in the Kingdom of Yahweh. It is to prepare you for ministry and prepare you for that kingdom. You have to do it. You are not just going to become a king of a nation without preparation. So what is the most important thing in your life right now? Is it just getting along in commercial Babylon or is it preparing to rule with Yahshua forever? And that is Yahweh's justice. That is what we should be focusing on.

Deuteronomy 19 and verse 21. He says,

Deuteronomy 19:21 *And your eye shall not pity; life shall go for life, eye for eye, tooth for tooth, hand for hand, foot for foot.*

And people read this and they think that is something bad. Because in some of the Muslim countries if you stole something they chop your hand off. That is not what it is talking about. When *saying eye for eye tooth for tooth, hand for hand, life for life*, it is talking about 'let the punishment fit the crime.' It is talking about that if you stole a piece of candy you are not going to get the death penalty. We will see that as we are going to read some of these judgments of Yahweh. So it is not a bad thing the eye for eye.

Even Yahshua when He came, even though that is a really good thing, Yahshua even went above that because mercy and justice and pity even means more than that ... even means more than that. So an eye for eye is justice - let the punishment fit the crime but also let there be mercy and forgiveness if there is repentance. That is what the New Covenant is about.

Matthew 5 and verse 38. He says,

Matthew 5:38 *You have heard that it was said "An eye for an eye, and a tooth for a tooth;" ... We just read it, right? ... but I say to you, Do not stand against the evil; but whoever strikes you on the right cheek, turn the other to him also.*

Comments: So is He literally telling you to go get beat up that if somebody robs you and beats you up, let him beat you up a second time? No. This is an analogy. It is an idiom. What He is saying basically is, that if somebody hits you on the right side, give them left side - meaning forgive them. That if somebody does something to you, if they stole from you, if they whatever it was - they lied to you, they lied about you, that you do not just hold bitterness forever against that person.

Meaning, by turning the cheek what it means is you are forgiving them and giving them the opportunity to do it again. So that is part of forgiveness. When you forgive somebody you are giving the opportunity. They could do it again. And that we're human beings we sin more than once. But that is the whole point of it. We have to give that opportunity if true repentance is there.

And it does not mean we are going to be perfect. And that is why do I forgive my brother once? Do I forgive him seven times? No, 77 times 77. We never stop forgiving. And that is what the turn the other cheek means. It means that when there is true repentance you are giving opportunity for forgiveness.

Matthew 5:40-42 *And to him desiring to sue you, and to take your coat, allow him also to have the cloak. And whoever shall compel you to go one mile, go with him two miles. He asking you to give, and he wishing to borrow from you, do not turn away.*

And somebody said to me one time, but isn't this like promoting evil? No, what this is doing is you have the free will. If there is repentance, if there is a change of heart, if you think that by doing this you could help somebody. This is your choice. This is where somebody isn't robbing you at gunpoint. It's where you are saying you don't have to rob me at gunpoint. I will give you my coat. If you are cold, I will give you my coat. So you are the one in the driver's seat.

You are the one that are making the choice in your life to put love before evilness. It doesn't mean you have to do it. It doesn't mean that if someone really is robbing you at gunpoint, that you are going to allow him to rob somebody else. No, it means that **you are giving the opportunity for forgiveness to turn the person's heart.** That's what it's about. But you are freely choosing it. It's not being forced upon you. That's what this idiom is all about here. So we are not condoning evil but willingly forgiving and showing mercy. This is justice ... this is justice.

Exodus 22. Let's go through now. And let's see. Let's see what Yahweh says about this because most times to have justice you do need restitution. It's just that simple. So yes, we do forgive. But if somebody stole all of your child's school fund and then they repented of it and they used it for whatever, that doesn't bring the school money back. So there does have to be restitution with forgiveness most of the time.

Now sometimes a person can't, sometimes if it's murder or something or whatever. There's just forgiveness and love and hope that it doesn't happen again. But most of the time when it is something that's being stolen

or taken or something wrong, there's restitution that has to go with it. So it's not just a matter of saying, "Ah yeah, I forgive you try better." No, that person has to make up for it. That's why we say you don't give back. You pay forward and you try to help somebody else not to be in that same situation.

So Exodus 22. I'm going to read the first 15 verses here. He said,

Exodus 22:1 *When a man steals an ox or a sheep, and kills it, or sells it, he shall pay five oxen for the ox, and four sheep for the sheep.*

Right? So four to one and five to one - that's restitution. And it also is a deterrent for people to do it. So the same way in Arab countries, not that I agree to it that if someone steals a piece of candy, they should have their hand cut off. But I'll tell you one thing. In most of those countries that have that as a law, you don't see any crime. It is a deterrent.

I remember one time, even in Kenya, where many, many years ago, we were driving somewhere. The man had a pickup truck. We had our suitcases in the back and we stopped for whatever to go in and get something. And we said, "Hey is our big is going to be good back here in an open pickup truck?" He said, "Oh yeah. If anybody came and tried to take your bag, people would yell, Thief! Thief! And everybody would come and stone him." So it's a deterrent against crime.

So you do need that because human nature is human nature.

Exodus 21:2 *If the thief is found breaking in, and is stricken and dies, no blood shall be shed for him.*

Comment: Yeah, he's breaking into your house and winds up being killed doing that, that there's no blood that would be shed for the thief that's doing that because he's in the wrong.

Exodus 22:3 *If the sun has risen on him, blood is due for him; repaying he will repay. If he has nothing, then he should be sold for his theft.*

Comment: So if somebody steals and that's where slavery comes from where Yahweh allows it to pay the debt back, not slavery forever, but to pay the debt back.

Exodus 22:4-5 *If the stolen thing finding is found in his hand alive, from ox to donkey to flock animal, he will pay double. When a man consumes a field or a vineyard, and he lets his beast loose and it consumes another's field, he shall repay the best of his field and the best of his vineyard.*

Yeah. So you have an animal that goes there and destroys somebody's property, then you're going to repay it with your property.

Exodus 22:6 *When fire breaks out and finds thorns, and shocked grain, or standing grain, or the field is burned up, repaying the one kindling the fire shall repay.*

Comment: So yeah, you go out there and start a fire recklessly and destroy somebody's field, you have to pay for it.

Exodus 22:7-8 *When a man gives silver or vessels to his neighbor to keep, and it is stolen from the man's house, if the thief is found, he will repay double. If the thief is not found, the master of the house shall be brought to Elohim, to see whether or not he put out his hand to his neighbor's goods.*

Comment: Because somebody was like, “Oh, it was stolen” and they're stealing it. So Yahweh's not stupid. All of these statutes and these judgments that are here, Yahweh's covering every base with it because He knows human nature.

Exodus 22:9 *In every matter of trespass, for ox, for donkey, for sheep, for clothing, for anything lost of which it is said that it is his, the case of both of them shall come to Elohim. Whom Elohim declares guilty, he shall repay double to his neighbor.*

Comment: So that's the point of it. Praise Yahweh in the congregation 99% of the time you don't have to worry about this because people are going to tell the truth. You do have that rare occurrence and I've had it where somebody does try to lie and they steal and then they lie. And those are usually people that aren't true believers anyway and they wind up, either being put out or leave but for 99% and true brethren they would never do this.

Exodus 22:10-11 *When a man gives a donkey or an ox to his neighbor; or a sheep, or any animal to keep, and it dies, or is injured, or is captured, no one seeing it, an oath of YAHWEH shall be between them both, that he has not put his hand to his neighbor's goods. And its owner shall take it, and he shall not repay.*

Comment: So here it is, your neighbor or your friend or brother and goes away and says, “Hey, can you watch my cat while I'm away” and you go away and the cat dies, nothing that the person did wrong. The cat just happened to die. There is no compensation has to be paid. It just happened. It wasn't because of negligence, which is right. That's justice. You're doing a favor for somebody and if something happens and you had to repay, people wouldn't do favors then. They would be afraid and that happens today. That's why many people that are witnesses to crimes are afraid to come forward because they wind up getting attacked or something or sued or whatever.

Exodus 22:13 *And if it is indeed stolen from him, he shall repay to its master. If it is completely torn in pieces, he shall bring it as a witness; he shall not repay that which was torn.*

Comment: So again, you're watching your brother or sister's cat or dog or something and an animal comes in, a wild fox or something, comes in and kills that animal. What can you do? It just happens.

Exodus 22:14 *And when a man borrows from his neighbor, and it is hurt, or dies, its owner not being with it, paying he shall repay.*

Comments: So but if you're borrowing something, if you're borrowing somebody's animal to plow your field and while you're plowing that animal gets hurt, of course you've got to pay back. I had this happen one time with a vehicle I had for work. That I use this vehicle for work and one of my workers asked, “Can I use it on Sunday to move something?”

Nothing to do with work, personal. And he took it and he broke the windshield. So he needs to replace that windshield because he's not using it for work. Now if he's using it for work and the windshield broke, he's my employee. I have to pay. If he's using it separately, that would be ... that's justice.

Exodus 22:15 *If its owner is with it, he shall not repay. If it is hired, it comes by its hire.*

So that's just the way it works. That's the way it works. Just like if you're renting a car and the windshield breaks in the car from Hertz or something like that. That's not your fault if it just happens and that's their company, their rental car company. So but of course they always want you to take the extra insurance, even though most of the times you don't have to because they're trying to get more money and that's more injustice in the world's sake.

So most times you need restitution for justice, but the person wronged can forgive out of mercy too. And I've had this happen where somebody used something and broke it or whatever and couldn't pay me back. And I said, "Don't worry about it. You know what? I know your heart is right. I know you tried. I know it wasn't your fault. Don't worry." We could have also mercy that comes in for restitution and forgive out of mercy.

But what is all this based on? **The justice is based on the Torah for morality and justice.** That's the problem today. If you don't have a standard for justice, then what are you going by? Now most countries have a law, right? What about law that comes from a constitution or whatever? Some of it is halfway decent. Some of the countries it's not, but you'll never have justice unless you have the means to bring the justice. And that's what the Torah is for. The Torah is not just law. It's instruction and it's instruction in morality. So it is important.

Luke 7 and verse 36. And like I said, justice is showing mercy when there is true repentance. Luke 7 and verse 36.

Luke 7:36-38 *And a certain one of the Pharisees asked Him that He eat with him. And going into the Pharisee's house, He reclined. And, behold, a woman who was a sinner in the city, knowing that He reclined in the Pharisee's house, taking an alabaster vial of ointment, And stood behind Him and was crying at His feet ... Yahshua talking about ... And she began washing His feet with her tears and then wiping with the hair of her head. And she was kissing His feet and anointing them with ointment.*

Luke 7:39-40 *And when that Pharisee who had invited Him saw that, he reasoned within himself and said that if this man was a prophet, He would realize who she is and what her reputation is. That woman, she is a sinner that who touched Him. And answering, Yahshua said to the man, Simon, I have a thing to say to you. And he said, speak, Rabbi.*

Luke 7:41-43 *There were two debtors to a certain creditor: the one owed five hundred denarii and one owed fifty. But because they did not have a thing to pay, he freely forgave them both. To which of them do you say will love him most? And answering, Simon said, I suppose the one to whom he freely forgave the most. And He said to him, You have judged rightly.*

Luke 7:44-45 *And turning to the woman, He said to Simon, Do you see this woman? I came into your house. You did not give water for My feet, but she washed My feet with tears and wiped off with the hairs of her head. You gave Me no kiss, but she from when I entered she did not stop fervently kissing My feet.*

Luke 7:46-47 *You did not anoint My head with oil, but this woman has anointed My feet with oil of incense. For I say this to you. Because her sins that are forgiven her are many, she has loved much. But he that is forgiven little loves Him little.*

Luke 7:48-50 *And He said to her, Your sins are forgiven. And those reclining with Him began to say within themselves, Who is this who even forgives sins? But Yahshua said to the woman, Your faith has given you life. Go in peace.*

So that's the point of the New Testament. We're all sinners at the same rate. The fact that we are all sinners and we do want to show mercy, **we don't want to allow that mercy to overtake justice** because when somebody is doing something wrong, when somebody did steal, if you don't allow them to pay that back, they're never going to learn from it. So you're not making them pay it back as a punishment. You're making them pay it back as justice.

So yes, there are times to show mercy, like in this case here, and especially when there's repentance. But many times by allowing a person due restitution, it helps them to grow and it helps them to see what they did wrong and it helps the system of justice. So that's where Yahweh's wisdom comes from His Spirit.

But in today's society, people only show leniency when they get something out of it. It's the same thing in politics, right? People are only showing leniency. You shake my hand, I shake your hand. And that's the way it works in this world system. Politicians are corrupt. It's the worst we've ever seen.

The World Economic Forum, everything is, how do politicians get in there? They don't work jobs most of them. They're having money that are given to them from all of these companies, these companies that have all the pharmaceutical companies and the oil companies and these other companies are giving all the millions dollars to put people in power. And then when they get in power, it's like they represented it.

So you're not going to see justice, you're not going to see mercy, you're not going to see it in Satan's system because they're doing the will, these politicians of their master's, so it's all corporate America, commercial Babylon who's running things.

Job 37 in verse 23, but it shouldn't be that way with Yahweh's people. Job 37 ... and particularly you want to make sure even when you're ordained, that we're still following justice, we're all following the same system. So we're not going to cover over offenses even if somebody is a deacon or an elder because it's the buddy system. No. The best way that you can help somebody, be a friend to somebody, is to show them their fault. And the best thing a person can do as a believer is repent of that and change. So Job 37 verse 23 says,

Job 37:23-24 *We cannot find Him, the Almighty; He is exalted in power; and He does not violate justice and abundant righteousness. So, men, fear Him; He does not see any who are wise of heart.*

So that's why we're to fear Yahweh, that's the One. It doesn't matter what man seems, it doesn't matter whether you're caught or not caught. We have to fear Yahweh, and if we did something wrong, we have to repent. We have to change, we have to make restitution, you have to make it right and then you move on, you move on from there.

Matthew 5:17 through 20 ... Matthew 5:17 through 20. And again, where is the basis of all that morality and justice have to come? From Yahweh's Torah! Without the Torah, what else would we be judging by - because human nature is evil! Matthew 5:17, Yahshua speaking says,

Matthew 5:17-19 *Do not think that I came to annul the Torah or the Prophets; I did not come to annul, but to fulfill. Truly I say to you, Until the heaven and the earth pass away, in no way shall one yod or one stroke pass away from the Torah until all comes to pass. Therefore, whoever loosens one of these commandments, the least, and shall teach men so, he shall be called the worst in the kingdom of Heaven. But whoever does and teaches them, this one shall be called great in the kingdom of Heaven.*

Comment: Meaning, he's not there. That in the Kingdom of Yahweh, that's what we're saying, these evil men that claim to be pastors, that claim to be, Bible-believing people and telling people the Torah is bad. We're telling people and they're not there. They're not in the kingdom.

Matthew 5:19b-20 *But whoever does and teaches them, this one shall be called great in the kingdom of Heaven. For I say to you, If your righteousness shall not exceed that of the scribes and Pharisees, ... and we saw what the scribes and Pharisees were ... you shall not enter into the kingdom of YAHWEH, never!*

So this is basically Yahweh's justice. The Torah cannot be replaced because there'd be no justice without it. **You need a basis for morality.** There's got to be a basis there. And **that basis is the Torah.** And that's why, like I said, the world was not created in incest. Yahweh says that incest is an evil thing for brothers and sisters to have relations and that kind of thing because it's evil. So He would never create the world through that because it's a law against what He's saying.

And yet today the world, they don't want to believe that there were other people in the Garden of Eden, not in the Garden of Eden, but created at that time. And they want to believe that it was okay then. And because of genetics, it became bad. No, no, it was evil from creation and its evil today. It's a perversion and it never changes. And that's why **the morality of the Torah is forever.** The morality of the Torah stands forever. And that is the basis for our morality.

Proverbs 21:2 and 3 ... Proverbs 21:2 and 3 says,

Proverbs 21:2-3 *Every way of a man is upright in his own eyes, but YAHWEH weighs the hearts. For YAHWEH, to do righteousness and justice is to be chosen more than sacrifice.*

He did not desire sacrifice, but justice; righteousness and justice. That's what is more important to Yahweh than killing an animal. It's not about going out there and lying and stealing and then saying, "Oh, let me just kill this animal and then I'll get all this weight off myself. My conscience will be clear." It doesn't work that way. No, the animal system like we know was just a reminder of them that they were sinners.

So to Yahweh, justice is vital for human beings because we reap what we sow. And if things in your life aren't going good, we do have to look at ourselves and we have to see are there things we're doing in our life that's not following Yahweh's system of justice that could be causing ... could be causing results that we're not happy with.

2nd Samuel 12 ... 2 Samuel 12, because we see here with King David, who did have a heart of ... even though he made big mistakes, not denying that, but he did have a heart of justice, right? He did rule with a heart of justice. 2 Samuel 12 says,

2nd Samuel 12:1-3 *And YAHWEH sent Nathan to David. And he came to him and said to him, There were two men in one city, the one rich, and the other poor. The rich one had flocks and very many herds. But the poor one had nothing except one little ewe lamb, who he had bought and nourished. And it grew up with him, and with his sons together, and it ate of his morsel, and it drank from his cup, and it lay in his bosom. And it was like a daughter to him ...* You know if you ever around the sheep, they are the cutest little things in the world.

2nd Samuel 12:4 *And a traveler came to the rich one, and he spared to take of his own flock, and of his own herd, to prepare for the traveler who had come to him. And he took the ewe lamb of the poor man, and prepared it for the man who had come to him.*

2nd Samuel 12:5-6 *And David's anger glowed ...* David doesn't know who this guy is. Actually, he's talking about him. Nathan's David is the guy, but he doesn't know this ... *and his anger glowed greatly against the man. And he said to Nathan, As YAHWEH lives, surely the man who did this is a son of death. And he will repay fourfold for the ewe lamb, because he has done this thing, and because **he had no pity.***

He had no pity. And today with all these millions of articles that go out every day and everybody gives their opinion there, it is human nature at it's worst *because iniquity abounds the love of many wax cold* and you're living it. You see people are so heartless and even when somebody has somebody that dies or there's a tragedy, people are heartless and there's no pity. There's no pity, there's no mercy and there's no sorrow for other people. Just the selfless human nature comes to its full. It's a Laodicean era. This is what we're living in. So David was a great king because he understood justice and he had pity on the poor.

Genesis 17, who else was the father of the faithful, the father of all three major religions today because he had this, Abraham. Genesis 18 ... Genesis 18. And Yahweh says this,

Genesis 18:18-19 *And Abraham shall surely become a great and powerful nation, ... Not only a great father, but a great and powerful nation ... and all the nations of the earth shall be blessed in him? ... And why is this? ... For I have known him, so that whatever he may command his sons and his house after him, even they may keep the way of YAHWEH, to do righteousness and justice; to the intent that YAHWEH may bring on Abraham that which He has spoken of him.*

And I say this, I give courses in the Bible school on child rearing and say like - Where are all the fathers gone? Where are all the mothers gone? And in the Bible, very rarely do you see a son that's following the father, even in the New Testament. Where's the Apostle Peter's son? Where's the Apostle Jacob's son? Where's the Apostle Andrew's son? Where are any of the sons of anybody there?

And many of the times like even King David, who was a good king and wasn't a good father really, we see the horror that his sons did. So we see the Abraham that became the *Father of the Covenant*, the everlasting covenant. Why? Because **Yahweh knew he'd take care of his son**. He was going to teach him. He was going to make sure that his children did not come that way. That he was going to teach them righteousness, like he

says, and justice to the intent that Yahweh has given to him. And Yahweh taught the Torah. That's what He says in **Genesis 26**, He says, *because Abraham obeyed, my statutes, my law, my Torah.*

Abraham was called because he taught justice to his sons. That word *justice* - the Hebrew word *Tsaddiq*, like the word *tsaddiq*. *Tsaddiq* means 'righteous one' - justice acting according to the proper standard of Elohim from the Torah, which is acting according to the Torah. Yahweh standard is the Torah with the commandments, the statutes and the judgments. Without the Torah, there is no standard of justice except man's perverted heart. And that's what people say, "I judge from my heart," the heart is deceitful above all things and desperately wicked.

And that's why I say as bad as it is, some of these Muslims going out and doing all this jihad and all this other evil stuff, and it is wicked. More wicked than that is a Christian pastor saying the Torah is nailed to a cross. The Torah is evil. The Torah is done away with it because without the Torah, **the Torah is the standard of justice.** There is no justice without the Torah ... there is no justice without the Torah. It's that simple. The Torah is the standard of justice. And without it, all you're left with is what we have today, man's evil perverted heart. And where does that leave us? Leaves us to the point of World War III where every man, woman and child on the planet is getting ready to possibly be killed because of man's perversion and evil heart.

Proverbs 1 and verse 8 ... Proverbs 1 and verse 8 says,

Proverbs 1:8 *My son, hear your father's instruction, and do not forsake the Torah of your mother;*

The congregation is like a mother. We should be teaching the Torah. And like I said, it is the foundation. It's the instruction for life. It can't give us life because we break it, but it's the foundation for life. It's the foundation of what is right and wrong and that never changes.

Jeremiah 23, but true righteousness will only come when the King of Righteousness comes. The Melchizedek, the King of Righteousness. Jeremiah 23:5 and 6,

Jeremiah 23:5-6 *Behold, the days come, says YAHWEH, that I will raise to David **a righteous Branch**, and a King shall reign and act wisely, and He shall do justice and righteousness in the earth ... Praise Yahweh ... In His days Judah shall be saved, ... there's still hope for our brother ... and Israel will dwell safely. And this is His name by which He shall be called, **YAHWEH TZEDEKENU** ... YAHWEH our Righteousness ... **YAHWEH TZEDEKENU.***

That's why I said that word in Hebrew, *tsaddiq*, which is 'righteous'. So that's the point of it. Only the King Yahshua can bring the justice and righteousness.

Isaiah 56 and verse 1, look what it says,

Isaiah 56:1 *So says YAHWEH: **Keep justice and do righteousness**, for my Y'shua is coming soon, and My righteousness will be revealed.*

Keep justice and do righteousness. That's our job. We are the ambassadors for this. This is the message we're bringing, the message of hope, the message of the kingdom of Yahweh. And anybody on this planet, no matter where you live, no matter who you are, no matter whether you're male or female, you can join this kingdom.

Praise Yahweh for that. Do justice, Yahshua is coming and like I said be part of the solution, not part of the problem.

Revelation 20 and verse 6, the last scripture here. Revelation 20 and verse 6.

Revelation 20:6 *Blessed and holy is the one having part in the first resurrection. The second death has no authority over these, but they will be priests of YAHWEH and of His Messiah, and will reign with Him a thousand years.*

That is our hope. That is our destiny, right? That is our vocation. That is our future to reign with Yahshua. We need to learn it now because it's not just the action it's the thought like Yahshua said. Remember? *The Torah says you shall not commit murder. I say if you even get angry at your brother you already committed, it's what's in our mind.*

As the people of Yahweh and having His Spirit live in us, that's what He's changing. Not just giving us discipline not to do the acts, but giving us the **true change of heart not to even have the thought**. That's the miracle I say when you look at those scriptures when the kingdom comes and it says, *they will learn war no more.*

Meaningly, it's not that there just isn't going to be war because you could destroy all the weapons that they can't make war. They won't learn war. They're not going to think about it. The thought of fighting somebody else will never be there. It's going to be cooperation and love and service to mankind.

We are the ambassadors for that kingdom. This is what these days are all about. Praise Yahweh. I bring this message as Yahweh's ambassador and servant. I've been blessed to go all over the world. I've been blessed to meet with world leaders, to go to different countries and share this message with the leaders and the politician people of countries, the religious leaders of countries.

I've been blessed to be invited to the Israeli Knesset more than 25 times and share this message of hope and peace. Even the one time, the blessing of going to United Nations and being Yahweh's ambassador even there to stand up for what true justice is.

I would never have thought that I'd have these opportunities now and I say Yahweh can use each and every one of you. The harvest is ready but the workers are few. And it doesn't matter, Yahweh, remember He used 12 ordinary men in Scripture. He didn't use the scribes and the Pharisees and all the ones with all the degrees and all that kind of stuff. He used people whose hearts could be changed and Yahweh could use any of us.

And the key is - do you want to be used? The key is taking it serious and being trained. How can you go out if you're not trained? Like I said, that's why we've had the Bible school for 22 years because we have to train the people to go out but each and every one of us now, the time is now, the great harvest is there and this open door that Yahweh gives us in Revelation, it's not going to be there forever. Revelation 3.

So let's do that. Let's be part of the solution instead of the problem. If you look for justice in the system of Satan, you're going to be really disappointed. The only true justice is in Yahweh's soon coming kingdom. As His ambassadors, we need to take this message to the world who needs it and we need to only look for justice by Yahweh, the King of Righteousness, not in Satan's system of commercial Babylon.

So wow, what's going on today? This war and all these other things, let's not get discouraged by it. It's inevitable that in this world you're going to have evil people and people that aren't looking for it. Let's be part of the solution. Let's go out there and let's every day of our life be a witness to Yahweh's justice and Yahweh's righteousness and be that example that will teach and bring others to faith and truth.

So I pray you have a great wonderful rest of this last day of Unleavened and Yahweh bless.
