

TRANSCRIPTION – The Word of YHWH_Part 2_It's Perfect Setting

Alrighty, Shabbat Shalom and Shabbat Shalom to those who are watching with us today. We are going over today part 2 of the series that I'm doing. Like I said, there will be at least three parts, possibly four parts, and on *The Word of Yahweh*. This is *The Word of Yahweh – Part 2 – It's Perfect Setting*.

And I want to start just by saying **how blessed we are to have the Bible**. I went over the last time about if you had just two or three or five manuscripts of an ancient philosopher, how people would say how amazing that is...sometimes even if it's just two. And yet, like I said, with just the New Testament there's more than fourteen thousand manuscripts and tens of thousands of manuscripts from the Tanach; and that **Yahweh has preserved His Word perfectly for us**.

It's not that we have part of the Book of Isaiah or part of the Book of Matthew or we have things missing with some of the scrolls are like that. Some of the old scrolls you find that they're finding, like the Dead Sea Scrolls, many portions of that are missing, but we have other scrolls to know what it says. And we went over last week how we can clearly see because they're thousands of years apart and they say the exact same thing.

So I hope as we're going through this series though that you're really, really thanking Yahweh how blessed we are to have the Bible...**how blessed we are to have to read it every day**. And I mean shame on anybody who's a true Believer that's not reading their Bible every day because the time is coming very shortly where we're not going to have those Bibles in our hand. And what you have is what you have in your memory from it; because the Holy Spirit can bring to memory in second something that's already been downloaded in your mind; but if you're never reading it and it's not there, it can't bring...so this why it's really, really important.

And remember in ancient times, people were basically illiterate. Why don't we find so many writings from the time of Abraham say; or the time of Moses and these things? Because they're just getting an alphabet, there wasn't even paper they're writing on; they're writing on stones...that's what they're doing. And most people were illiterate because of that.

So in even up until just a few hundred years ago, the only Bible you might see is in a synagogue; or maybe in a congregation or a church somewhere; but **the average person did not have a Bible in their house**. And today we're blessed, not with one Bible, but with ten Bibles, fifteen Bibles, Lexicon, Concordance; all these different study aids that we have....and like I say, shame on us if we're not using them and appreciating that we have them.

And by that, as more technology comes out...you remember **Daniel 12:4**...that knowledge will be increased in the end time. And with this knowledge, it's bad knowledge; they have knowledge to make nuclear weapons to destroy every man, woman and child off the face of the earth; but it's also good knowledge...Bible knowledge...like I said, Concordance, Lexicons, study aids, all of these different word studies...things we have that they never had before **to help us to prove that the Bible could only be written by Yahweh**; as it's put together perfectly.

There's no way...and it's not even that one man...let's just say that, take away from the fact of when He lived and all the different stuff...but let's say, one man...let's say it was Moses who put the whole Bible together, right? Even that would be almost impossible for one person to put everything together perfectly. But like we said the last time, that here it is, **you have over forty men over the period of like fifteen hundred years all writing at different times**; and even parts of scripture like we'll see the next time like with the Book of Psalms

is written by different people at different times over one thousand years and it's altogether perfect.

How on earth can that be? There are no contradictions, everything works perfectly.

And even things in Scripture like we went over the last time...we'll go over today...that people didn't even know at that time that they're writing. They have scientific facts that people didn't know and yet, it's written there in the Bible. So Psalm 14 in verse 1 says:

Psalm 14:1 *The fool has said in his heart, There is no Elohim!*

And like, I'm not going to go there again...we went the last time in **Romans 1**...**Romans 1** clearly shows **creation itself proves there has to be a Creator**. Everything is so intricate of creation. So it really is a fool that's going to sit there and say there is no Elohim. Psalm 12 in verse 6...and interesting scripture...Psalm 12 in verse 6 says:

Psalm 12:6 *The Words of YAHWEH are pure Words...pure words meaning they're not only pure in their meaning but they're perfect. They're all sequentially in a perfect order. There's nothing that's inaccurate. There's nothing that's wrong except there are times we see in the Bible where there's a copyright error, right? There could be something where the number should be four thousand and it was put four hundred or forty. So sure, when man touches it there's always that chance and there are a few things. That's one of the reasons why I put together the Hebraic Roots Bible because of translational errors; not an error in Scripture when Yahweh inspired it, but a translational error when people are translating or copying it. But it says... *The Words of YAHWEH are pure Words, like silver refined in an earthen furnace, **purified seven times**...purified seven times.**

And we'll see that today as we look at sequential orders of things. That the number seven, right, I went over this before when I went over things on the Shemita and all the different things, right? **Seven is such an important number; the number of completion**. The earth and all creation is made in six days and on the seventh day Yahweh rested. And then we have seven sevens, 49, the count to Shavuot, the count to the Jubilee and the 50th is set apart. Because seven times seven is a complete cycle; 49...and we'll see that as we go into things today.

So the Word of Yahweh refined in an earthen furnace, purified **seven times**; because there were seven world empires that were there, right? This empire now, this Babylonian empire that Babylon will fall and then the Beast power will rise but it's all part of the last world empire that's here. And **every empire Yahweh's Word is being purified**, right? There were seven world empires...we're living in the last one...and the Word of Yahweh purified in each one. And now we're in the one where it's being restored, right? The end time talks about all things being restored.

And how many things do we see here? Like I said, with things like the Dead Sea Scrolls and archeology and every other week or every other month they're finding something out in science and DNA...like we went over...all these amazing things that prove that Yahweh is perfect.

I went over the last time about there's 22 letters in the Hebrew alphabet, that there were originally 22 books in what we call the Tanach. Why is it the Tanach? Because it's an acronym...it's an acronym for the Law, the Prophets and the Writings. The Torah, the Neviim and the Ketuvim, right; the Law, the Prophets and the Writing...The Torah, the Neviim and the Ketuvim...it's an acronym meaning Tanach...that comes from that.

So there are twenty-two original books in the original Tanach. And then, like I said, in the Brit Chadashah, the New Testament, which is paralleling that...it's not doing away with it...it's paralleling it, it's explaining it, right? We also...originally in the original Aramaic Peshitta, there is only 22 books, why? Because the last five weren't

written yet. The Book of Jude and the three Books of John...the epistles of John...not the good news of John, but the epistles and Revelation...they weren't ready yet but then they were added later. Isn't that interesting that there are also...although there's 22 letters in the Hebrew alphabet...there's five what they call *sofit* letters. That if a letter comes at the end of a word, it looks different...it looks different.

So interesting...that would make 27 forms of letters and then you have, like I said, 22 Books in the Tanach; you have 27 Books in the Brit Chadashah; and it perfectly comes to 49...seven times seven. So that's why, like I said, there is no book of Enoch. Enoch didn't have an alphabet. Enoch didn't know how to write. Enoch never wrote a book. It's an apocryphal book that we have no idea who put that thing together. It was at a time where they were writing a lot of different apocryphal books.

Just like in the New Testament there are all different kinds of apocryphal New Testament, by who? By Byzantines...by people in the fourth to the ninth century that were living in monasteries all by themselves with a lot of wine and a lot of time on their hands. And wow, did they write some wild stuff. And a lot of the Catholic doctrine and Christian doctrine unfortunately comes from a lot of that nonsense that's in there. But **we have the purified Word of Yahweh** like it says here: *the Words of Yahweh are pure like silver refined in an earthen furnace, purified seven times.*

So I just want to go over now about the book order; because **the book order is extremely important**, right? If you're reading a book, you're not going to read chapter 7 before you read chapter 4; you're not going to read chapter 9 before you read chapter 12. So Yahweh put the book order in a perfect way in a perfect order and mankind has changed it.

We see first of all, if you look in the Tanach, you'll see that they changed the order of the books from the Torah and the Prophets and the Writings. And they'll put Psalms before Isaiah and they'll put Ezra way up there...and the same thing before the Prophets. They have it all mixed up. They'll have Chronicles in the place where Chronicles should be the last book of scripture. And it was Ezra who actually codified this and put it all together in that perfect form there at the end, having it all. But the book order is very important. But I want to go over more of the book order in the Brit Chadashah...the book order of the New Testament; because that order is really out of whack.

And it was in the fourth century that the Roman bishops...and remember as Constantine comes...and Constantine is a pagan sun worshipper...and all of a sudden he has a vision of a cross that's pagan; and then he wins the battle and he says, "I am now a Christian". What did that mean? That means that out of his own words, not my words, but quoting him, "that every single thing that we were doing to paganism and the worship of the sun, we will now do to Elohim". So Constantine really did no favors to Christianity and he made his own form of it. That's why we don't even want to use the word today. Because when someone thinks of Christian, they think of somebody who is lawless, somebody who is pagan, somebody who is doing all these things. Although early on, the word Christian did not mean that. Today that's the connotation and that's what we try to stay away from.

But originally what we have is we have the four Good News messages; Matthew, Mark, Luke and John and the Book of Acts goes with that; because they're all telling the story about the Messiah. It's the history, the early Congregation, and it's the red-letter words of Messiah Himself, right? And isn't that interesting?

And we'll see this even in the next message, the number five, right...it's a really important number because it's the number of grace, but there's a reason why there's five books of the Torah. There's a reason why there's four Good News messages and the Book of Acts, that **those five books parallel the Torah**. They're the most

important things, that's where the doctrine is coming from...that's the foundation of the Tanach and that's the foundation of the Brit Chadashah, the New Testament.

Then after that, what do you have? You have the seven epistles of the senior elders. You have Jacob first, right, why? Because he's the brother of Yahshua; he's the leader of the Congregation in Jerusalem; and even Josephus is writing about Jacob, how righteous he was; and how wrong it was when they killed him. So you have Jacob, then you have Cephas, Peter, who again, winds up being the lead apostle; especially in the work to the nations, to the lost sheep of the House of Israel. And then you have John, John who lived the longest and he's also the third pillar there that we see. And of course, Jude is also in there also in those seven epistles. So then after that, you have the epistles of Paul, starting with Hebrews; because that's the most important epistle that he's writing; fourteen epistles he writes in all and then the Book of Revelation.

So that's the order that the books should be in. And even if you go to the Books of Galatians...let's go to Galatians 2 in verse 9...we see this because there's a judicial order...and we talk all the time about **judicial order**. But you see it in everything. And you certainly see it in the way the Bible is put together; because the Bible was not haphazardly put together. And as we're going to see today, if you have words and phrases and books out of order, you're going to miss a lot of the amazing things that Yahweh has inscribed and encoded into the Bible that way...but Galatians 2 in verse 9...this is the Apostle Paul saying, it says:

Galatians 2:9 *And knowing the grace given to me, Jacob and Cephas and John...Yochanan...those seeming to be pillars, gave right hands of fellowship to Barnabas and to me, that we go to the nations, but they to the circumcision;*

So we even see it's there. Jacob, Cephas (Peter) and John written in that order and that's the way the order of...you could say, importance...because of their order, their rank order. The same way if you remember when Joseph's brother's came to him, right, when they were slavery and they're coming for the food down there in Egypt; and then Joseph...they're sitting with Joseph to eat...and it says even that all the **brothers sat according to their rank**...according to age, according to judicial order. So **judicial order is in everything**; and we see it over here. If you go to back to Galatians 1 in verse 17, Paul says:

Galatians 1:17 *nor did I go up to Jerusalem to the apostles before me...*

The apostles before me, right, before him **in rank**. Even 1st Corinthians 15 in verse 9...I'll go there...1st Corinthians 15 in verse 9...what does the Apostle Paul say? He says:

1st Corinthians 15:9 *For I am the least of the apostles, who am not worthy to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the Congregation of YAHWEH.*

So why then if this was so evident, right...it's so evident that, number one you see that Jacob and Peter and John were also eye witnesses of Yahshua; which also why it puts them the premacy before the Apostle Paul. Paul was an eye witness; but after Yahshua's resurrection it was different. Paul was not with Yahshua when he was physically a human being on this earth. So why would they change it?

And the reason they changed it was...and its diabolical conspiracy...is because **they were trying to change the premise of judicial order from Jerusalem to Rome**. And it's been there now for the last sixteen, seventeen hundred years...so because Paul is the apostle to who? Paul is the apostle to the Romans. He wrote the epistle to the Romans. Paul is the apostle to the Gentiles. He's going to these Gentiles; he's going to these Gentile areas. So **they put his epistles first to try to show pre-evidence of Rome in the early Congregation**. And then they put Jacob and Peter (Cephas) and John way in the back so to **degrade** the importance of Jerusalem and the early Jewish Believers.

So that's why in our Scriptures, right, we put the books back in the order and you might look at it and you might say...why then, if that's the case, why then is the Good News put together the way they are, right? The Good News are: Matthew, Mark, Luke and John. Why would John be the fourth Good News message?

Well, if you look in all the writings, one thing is really, technically, the good news of Mark...is not really the good news of Mark...it's the good news of Peter. Peter was the writer; Mark was simply just the secretary who's writing it down...that's what all the records show us. And Peter definitely was a first-hand eyewitness.

Matthew who was Levi...who was actually a priest...so the priests and prophets they have pre-eminence...so that's okay. And then Luke was writing actually from the standpoint of the Apostle Shaul (Paul) who is with him. But John was the last one. See those three Good News messages, Matthew, Mark and Luke, they call them the synoptic Good News messages because they all basically tell the same stories, right? And they tell it: *in the mouth of two or three witnesses, let everything be established.*

Yochanan, John's good news came thirty years after this. So the New Testament was pretty much formatted and then John's good news came in to solidify it, right? So he was the one actually that wanted it fourth, but there's also another reason. Because the Good News actually parallel something else...let's go there...let's go to Revelation 4...Revelation 4...and it parallels something that's amazing that actually is in Heaven itself...Revelation 4 verse 1 and 2 says:

Revelation 4:1-2 *After these things I saw. And behold, a door being opened in Heaven! And I heard the voice as the voice of a trumpet speaking with me, saying, Come up here, and I will show you what needs to happen after these things. And immediately I came into the spirit. And, behold, a throne was set in Heaven, and One sitting on the throne.*

So wow, this is the now...he's seeing something, it's a vision okay, he's not actually there but he's seeing the third Heaven and then drop down to verse 6 and look what he's seeing...

Revelation 4:6 *and a sea of glass was before the throne, like crystal. And in the midst of the throne and around the throne were **four living creatures**, full of eyes before and behind. And the first living creature was like a **lion**...right? Like the book Matthew; whose written to the Jews; the Lion of Judah... *the second living creature was like a **calves**...an ox, because the Good News of Mark and Peter was showing the strength of the Son of Man, right, like the ox...and then the third living creature was like the **face of a man**...Luke's good news was written to the Gentiles...and the fourth living creature was like an **eagle** flying...the eagle soars into the heavens and it's the spiritual one.**

And that's John's good news; he's not one of the synoptic Good News. You don't see the same stories that are in Matthew, Mark and Luke. You something totally different **showing Yahshua as Elohim**. Because this is where when he's writing one of the reasons he's inspired to write is, Gnosticism is taking over at that time. And they're trying to say that Yahshua never came in the flesh and all these other gnostic beliefs. So John has to show that Yahshua was born in the flesh; but also **He was literally Deity; He was Elohim**. So that's why his is put there to parallel this. And where does this come from? This doesn't come from Revelation; this actually comes from Ezekiel 1:5 and 6...let's go there...Ezekiel 1:5 and 6, it says:

Ezekiel 1:5-6,10 *Also from its midst came the likeness of **four living creatures**...just like we're reading...And this was how they looked: they had the **likeness of a man**, and four faces were to each, and four wings were to each of them...drop down to verse 10...And the likeness of their faces: **the face of a man**, and **the face of a lion**, **the face of an ox** on the left to the four of them, and **the face of an eagle** to the four of them.*

So we see the same thing; we see the lion, the ox, the man and the eagle. And I'll just read our note here on the bottom of the page it says: these faces show the four Good News books and aspects of Yahshua Messiah. Matthew was written to the Jews and represents the lion; which is Judah's symbol. Mark shows Messiah as the Servant of Yahweh; and is depicted as the ox, who is the hardest working animal for man. Luke was written for the nations; and shows the face of man that Messiah came for all mankind. And Yochanan, John's good news message typifies the eagle who is sent to the heavens and represents Messiah as Elohim.

So very, very clearly this is why we see the book order the way they are; and this is why it represents it. Like I said, **every single thing of Scripture is put together exactly the way it needs to be**. And even changing that book order...and this is why I say...I did a message a while ago at the Feast, a Bible study on the Hebraic Roots Bible and the importance of it...but **that Bible is part of the restoration ministry of restoring all things**.

And it's not me; I didn't restore it. Yahweh is restoring it. But that's why the Hebraic Roots Bible is so important because **the order of the books is right; the judicial order**. If we're talking about bringing judicial order back into the world and back into the Congregation, back into the family, and back into marriages and all these other things, then you have to start with the Word of Yahweh; because that's the **foundation of all knowledge**. And it has to be put together correctly. So it's extremely important that these books are put together the right way. 2nd Timothy 3 in verse 16...2nd Timothy 3 in verse 16 says:

2nd Timothy 3:16-17 *All Scripture is written by inspiration of the Holy Spirit and is profitable **for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness**, so that the man of YAHWEH may be perfected, and complete for every good work.*

So **it's really important that we don't change the Word of Yahweh**. And matter of fact, it talks about in Deuteronomy that if someone even removes one word he's going to lose his part in eternal life. So we want to make sure that we're keeping the scripture exactly the way that Yahweh put it. So now, I want to kind of turn the page a little bit and I want to go to Proverbs 25 in verse 2 because it says:

Proverbs 25:2 *The glory of Elohim is to conceal a matter but the glory of kings is to search out a matter.*

And last week I was going into the different scriptures...some of them in the Book of Job, the oldest book in the Bible, right, almost four thousand years old...it's showing how on earth could Job know these things that he wrote? Because he wasn't writing it; **Yahweh was writing them**. How could Job know about gravity? And how could Job know the earth is hanging on nothing? When you look at all the paganism things right, they always show atlases holding up the world; these false, ridiculous things and false gods that they have. But yet, Job knew that the earth is hanging on nothing. He knew about gravity, like I said.

So *the glory of Elohim is to conceal a matter but the glory of kings is to search out a matter*. And that's the exciting part. And I know it was exciting to me coming into the truth and learning all these little things about the Bible; and knowing that **the Bible is not just a book of man**...it's impossible. **There's no way that man could write that book**. And I'm going to show you today why that is; because **there are things that are written there and encoded there that human beings could never, ever have put in there**. They couldn't...it's impossible for human beings to know that.

Many things are hidden in Scripture and prove that only Elohim could have put the Bible together in its perfect order. One of the things is: did you know that there are 365 verses on not having fear. I mean people fear a lot of things and that's what causes a lot of problems in people's life. It's the opposite of faith; and without faith it's impossible to please Elohim...to please Yahweh. And yet, there's 365 on not having fear; one for every day of the year...that Yahweh put that in there. So you could actually do that. You could, every day of the year, read a

different verse on not having fear. And like I said, these are little, little tidbits that Yahweh puts in there. And there's no way that all of it when you put together...maybe that one fact could have been a coincidence...but we'll see today there's no way on earth that all these things could be a coincidence together.

I want to start in Genesis 5, and I want to show you, because Genesis 5 is the first genealogy that we see in Scripture; and genealogies are important, why? Because the first Adam failed and the second Adam had to come from the genealogy of the first Adam; after the second Adam comes, we don't see any more genealogies because they're not that important. So the genealogy isn't important to us, right? Some people try to go back in there genealogy and see, are they from the tribe of Dan, or are they from the tribe of Naphtali...and that's okay, nothing wrong with it; but it's not important because we're all from...we're all grafted into Messiah like it says in **Galatians 3:29**: *if you be of Messiah, then you are a seed of Abraham and an heir according to the promise*. But the genealogy was very important before Messiah came because if the genealogy is broken up, then what happens? The Messiah can't come. Look what it says:

Genesis 5:1-9 *This is the book of the generations of Adam...Adawm...in the day that Elohim created mankind, He made him in the likeness of Elohim. He created **them** male and female...right, so Yahweh took Adam from mankind that He created, He brought Adam into the garden and He makes the other one male and female... and blessed them, and called their name "**Adawm**" (mankind) in the day when they were created...Now it goes into the genealogy, right... And Adam lived one hundred and thirty years and fathered a son in his own likeness, according to his image, and called his name Seth. And the days of Adam after he fathered Seth were eight hundred years. And he fathered sons and daughters. And all the days that Adam lived were nine hundred and thirty years. And he died. And Seth lived one hundred and five years, and fathered Enos. And after he fathered Enos, Seth lived eight hundred and seven years. And he fathered sons and daughters. And all the days of Seth were nine hundred and twelve years. And he died. And Enosh lived ninety years and fathered Cainan.*

So this goes on and on and on, right? And we see the genealogy that's there. The amazing part about this, right...and this is in the very beginning of the Bible; this is Genesis 5. And the rabbis who have Gematria which means every single...there wasn't originally numbers...but every letter had a number value. And you could look another amazing thing...and maybe we'll get into a little bit another time. But another thing that shows that **only Yahweh could have written the Bible because of those number values**.

When you look at the number value of words and how they add up to all these different things, there are so many things in just the number values that would blow your mind. And no way could a human being ever do that. But the rabbis missed something here just in the simple translation of the names. Because like I said, **every name in Hebrew has meaning to it**. So what do these names mean? I want to show you what these names mean, right?

Adam has Seth; Seth has Enos; Enos has Cainan; Cainan has Mahalaleel; Mahalaleel has Jared; Jared has Enoch; Enoch has Methuselah; Methuselah has Lamech; and Lamech has Noah. Well, what do these names mean? The first ten names mean: man is appointed mortal sorrow, but the blessed Elohim shall come down **teaching** that His death shall bring the longed after or despairing rest. So you could see it right here that the very first ten name, right; man has been appointed mortal sorrow, but the blessed Elohim shall come, right, down teaching that His death shall bring despairing or the longed after or comfort or rest.

Now what are the chances that that could just be in there? And why would the Hebrew rabbis put that in there? That's showing Yahshua coming to the earth to pay the penalty of sins. They would never in a million years put that in there. And yet, we see from the very beginning that Yahweh does have things encoded in the Bible. He has things encoded in names. He has things encoded other ways, right?

So we see that this is just one thing in the very beginning that Yahweh has encoded. And you could read that a hundred times, you'd never even think about this unless you put the names down and you see. But it shows the Plan of Salvation laid out **from the very beginning**. And you have to understand that. You have to understand why **Genesis 3:15**, right...about the first Messianic prophecy of a seed being born to Adam and Eve to **redeem** what the first Adam lost...okay.

Now I want to go into something that is a little, even more, amazing that Yahweh has encoded in scripture; and it's called, The Bible Code. Most people listening to this probably have heard of the Bible Code...maybe many of you have read books they have on the Bible Code...but what is the Bible Code? Well like I said, this is a code, of what I just read is one form of the code. But I want to go over a code that's called **E-L-S...ELS: Equal Distance Letter Sequence**...Equal Distance Letter Sequence.

And there was a Israeli Hebrew Mathematician called, Eli Rips, who made this ELS famous, starting maybe in the 70's and the 80's, and particularly in the 90's, when the book, *The Bible Code* came out; where they started to see when computers were coming. They started to see that there is actually codes written in scripture that without computers, would be almost impossible to find. But with computers, they show, wow, they things are so amazing that **mankind could never have done** this...put this together himself.

So what am I talking about? What is Equal Distance Spacing? I'm going to show you here a matrix, right, and we have today a Bible...most of you have an English Bible that's written in columns or whatever...but **the original Bible was written in scrolls**, right? And even what I just showed you on those names...I'll show it again...I don't know if you picked up on that...that it looks like a scroll, right? Which means this would have been rolled up...(see if I can roll this here real quick)...and then it would have been opened like this; like a scroll, right?

So the books we have today are very different than what the Bible was originally. **The Bible originally was not broken down into chapters**. Whenever you see chapter breaks, chapter 19, chapter 20, chapter 21, that was all put in there later. Not only that, not only was it broken down in chapters, it was not even broken down into words. All you had were letters. So originally in the Bible, you had to just see all these letters and read it. Now again, if you understood Hebrew it would be the same. Like in English today, you could do the same. A matter of fact, with a computer you could do it.

Take something, any kind of writing, you have a computer and just take the spaces out between the words; and if you put them altogether you could still read it, but it's a little awkward to read it without the spacing; and why is that? Because sometimes, when you don't have the spacing there could be another word that comes up, right? And this is what, basically, Equal Distance Letter Sequence is. It's skipping so many letters and then words become from there. And not just words become from there, syllables become from there.

So why is this so amazing? Because **it's not in anything else in the world except for the Bible**. They tested this on other things; and just like anything, you can corrupt it, right? And even the Bible Code can be corrupted. And I'm very cautious with the Bible Code because there's many, many books that have come out since Michael Drosnin's book.

And you could say, "Okay, if you go 8,400 letters to the left..." in a two-letter or three-letter word, you could come up with this word. That's not what I'm talking about. What I'm talking about is **very defined** codes skipping certain amount of letters. In certain cases forty-nine letters, seven times sevens; or seven letters or nine letters, or twelve letters, whatever it is...coming up with words and phrases that actually, **the words in the phrase relate to the text itself!** So what are the chances of that? What are the chances that something can be encoded in the Bible by skipping these letters and it couldn't make any sense whatsoever?

Now granted, let's say I did that. Let's say I wanted to put in the Bible whatever; I wanted to put the name of YAHWEH, right, Yod-Hey-Vav- Hey...I could theoretically put Yod-Hey-Vav-Hey in whatever...every seven letter intervals, right, but now I have to make the text read by that. I'm going to have to figure out words and phrases that fit into that, that code that I put in there.

And when you think about **at the time of the Torah being written, there was no language**. Hebrew became a language and it was the...and remember you go from ancient cuneiform language into the paleo Hebrew, that is pictures that becomes a language, to Mount Sinai where...and I have, anyone that's new or you haven't heard it...go online and listen to the message with Mount Sinai and the beginning of language (*The Word of Yahweh and Mount Sinai*) because it's clearly proved that that's when Hebrew became a language. Because Yahweh as He's giving the Torah, He can't do it in hieroglyphics because then He'd have to etch animals into the stone; which is against His Commandment that He's writing. So He gives an alphabet; and you can't tell me that Moses or somebody else, that most of these people are even **illiterate** that they couldn't code these things in there. It's virtually impossible and we'll see it as you see these codes that are here.

So let's start and let me show you what I mean by this, right? That also in every case it's not just that something is encoded in a scripture that **the text relates to the code** which is virtually impossible. So I want to start in Deuteronomy 4 in verse 32...Deuteronomy 4 verse 32...what is it about? It's about asking about Yahweh about He did creation, right? It says:

Deuteronomy 4:32 *For ask now of the days past which were before you, since the day that Elohim created man on the earth, and from the one end of the heavens to the other end of the heavens, whether there has been a thing as great as this, or has anything seen like this...is anything like it been heard.*

So he's talking about creation and he's saying, "Ask Elohim about creation." Well, what's important about that scripture? Do you want to know that you're asking Yahweh about the foundation of the world that **85 elements are encoded in that scripture**...85 elements. And you got to realize that **many of these elements were not even known at that time**. So now it can't be...even if you had...even if Moses was some kind of mathematician that we didn't know about...how could you encode something in there that you couldn't know?

So what are some of the elements that are encoded? Gold, lithium, oxygen, hydrogen, helium, uranium, plutonium, ligh, tin, mercury, iron, sodium, lead, nitrogen; the name of Elohim is around the cluster nine times. So you have 85 elements there. Like I said, many of them that they didn't even know existed and you have the name of Elohim around it nine times.

And that's what happens because once you make the matrix...and this is just a basic matrix...once the matrix comes in...and there's programs, you can get programs that do this for you...so you would take, where I was just there in **Deuteronomy 4:32**...you would take Deuteronomy 4:32 and you have the matrix there and then the matrix would show you, right, all of these 85 elements and then you would see Elohim, Elohim, Elohim, Elohim all around the elements showing that mankind couldn't have done that. There's no way that mankind could have done that; only Yahweh could have done that.

So let's go to the next one...okay, it's in Genesis 7 in verse 5...Genesis 7 in verse 5 it says:

Genesis 7:5-8 *And Noah did as to all that YAHWEH commanded him. Noah was a son of six hundred years, and the flood of waters was on the earth. And Noah went in, and his sons, and his wife, and his sons' wives with him into the ark, because of the water of the flood. And they went in to Noah into the ark, male and female of clean animals, and of animals that are not clean, and of fowl, and of every thing that creeps on the earth,*

So here it is, pretty simple scripture, right? It's all about Noah going into the ark and Yahweh saving mankind. Well, if you start...if you look in this **Genesis 7:5-8** and you skip every nine letters in that sequence, it spells: **the sons escape**...of course in Hebrew...the sons escape. So that's what I'm trying to say **that the code relates to the surface text** which you don't have anywhere else.

Let's go to the next one...Genesis 38...this is a pretty interesting one...Genesis 38:1-3...Genesis 38:1-3. Now what does Genesis 38? Genesis 38 is about the whole genealogy of Judah, right? Judah, the son of Jacob, where Yahshua comes from. So it's **Yahshua's genealogy**...how it started...and it says:

Genesis 38:1-3 *And it happened at that time that Judah went down, away from his brothers, and turned aside to a man of Adullam named Hirah. And Judah saw there a daughter of a Canaanite man named Shuah. And he took her, and went in to her. And she conceived and bore a son. And he called his name Er.*

Now I'm not going to go to the rest of the scriptures here because then it shows that he had the other two sons and the son died; and then he promised the daughter-in-law that when the younger son got older he would send the younger son; and he never did; and she makes believe she's a prostitute so Judah can in so that the lineage can continue, right, because the lineage has to continue to Messiah.

So we know the story; it's about the **genealogy of Judah**, the tribe that Yahshua is from; but encoded in this chapter...and again every 49 letters - seven times seven: completeness. Remember what we said? The count to Shavuot, 49 – seven times seven; the fiftieth is Shavuot; the same with the Jubilee, seven times seven – the fiftieth is the Jubilee. So seven times seven it's showing completeness, right, a completeness and unity of everything.

So skipping every 49 letters, you know what it spells? It spells: **Judah, Tamar, Boaz, Ruth, Obed, Jesse and David; the whole genealogy of Yahshua from Judah in chronological order**...in chronological order. So it can't be a coincidence. Some people say, "Oh well it's a coincidence!" Maybe it's a coincidence if the name Judah was there and maybe the name Tamar was there; but Judah, Tamar, Boaz, Ruth, Obed, Jesses, David; all in chronological order. Do you understand in the laws of odds and probability...I went into it in the last time...what the laws in the odds and probability are that when you're skipping every 49 letters and you come out with the name Judah that right that would be the name Tamar, right, and then Boaz, and then Ruth; because **every letter has to be right**.

If one letter is wrong and as you get to the point that okay, now you had Judah, Tamaz, Boaz, Ruth, now that you're getting to Obed, already it's **magnified**; because it's not just finding Obed, you found all them before him and every letter from there and Jesse and David; **all in chronological order**. So it wasn't just that they're all there...it wasn't that Obed came before Ruth or Jesse came before Boaz...they're all in perfect chronological order. There is no way on earth that this could happen except if Yahweh did it. It's impossible! It's an impossibility that it could be encoded and encoded where? Not just anywhere, but **encoded in the very chapter of the genealogy of Yahshua**.

So I mean, amazing...it absolutely is amazing that to think that Yahweh could encode all that and make the text **make sense** and yet, it's perfect; it's because His Word is perfect, right? It's purified seven times and it's perfect.

Let's go to the next one and it's in Genesis 2:7-9 and it goes until Genesis 3 in verse 3. That's where the code is...but I'll just read to you Genesis 2 verse 7-9:

Genesis 2:7-9 *And YAHWEH Elohim formed the man from the dust of the ground, and blew into his nostrils the breath of life; and the man became a living soul. And YAHWEH Elohim planted a garden in Eden to the*

east; and He put the man whom He had formed there. And out of the ground YAHWEH Elohim made to spring up every tree that is pleasant to the sight, and good for food. The Tree of Life was also in the middle of the garden; also the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil.

And you know I'm just going to read there but the code that I'm going to show you goes all the way until **Genesis 3:3**. So what do you think would be encoded there? We're going to skip every 21 letters, right...3, the number of resurrection, the number of unity; by 7, the number of completion. So skipping every 21 letters, you know what it comes out with? Well, what are we reading about here? We're reading about the trees in the Garden of Eden. You know what the code is? All the trees in the Garden of Eden.

It mentions twenty-five different foods and trees that are in the Garden of Eden, okay. It mentions: wheat, vine, grape, chestnut, date, acacia, bramble, cedar, nut, fig, willow, pomegranate, aloe, tamarisk, oak, poplar, cassia, almond, mastic, hazel, olive, fir...okay. **It names all of these trees and food exactly in the scripture of Yahweh talking about putting the man in the garden to take care of the trees.** And these are all...like I said, skipping 21 letters; it's naming all of these. So it's all in a sequence. So it's **not haphazard**. It's not just trying to fit something in there; it's in a **perfect sequence**, right, seven times three...amazing...amazing when you think about that.

Let's go to the next one...Genesis 3:15...talk about that a lot, right? The first Messianic prophecy, a very, very important scripture...I'll read it here for you.

Genesis 3:15 *And I will put enmity...this is Yahweh talking when Adam and Eve and the serpent disobeyed Him...I will put enmity between **you**...talking to the woman...talking to the serpent...I will put enmity between you and the woman...right...and between your seed and her seed. He will bruise your head and you shall bruise his heel.*

And that's what happened, right? As Yahshua is being crucified, the nail is going through His heel; but Yahshua crushes the head of the serpent; He defeats him, right? So this the scripture...an important Messianic scripture...and when you start with the first *yod* and you skip 69 letters, it spells the name Yahshua. So now we're seeing that it's **identifying** who the Son of Adam is going to be. And just like we said in the last time in Matthew: *you shall call His name Yahshua because He will save His people from their sins*...right? That's what the name Yahshua means: **Yahweh's salvation**.

Next, let's go to another Messianic scripture here...Isaiah 53 in verse 10...Isaiah 53 in verse 10, it says:

Isaiah 53:10 *But YAHWEH pleased to crush Him...talking about this is a prophecy of the Messiah, what He's going to do; how He's going to suffer; how He's going to pay the penalty of sins, says...But YAHWEH pleased to crush Him, to make Him sick, so that If He should put His soul as a guilt offering, He shall see His seed; He shall prolong His days; and the will of YAHWEH will prosper in His hand.*

Right, so now I want to show you that in this scripture...and again, it goes into the next scripture, or the next scripture...it **starts** from this scripture, from Isaiah 53:10...maybe even sometimes a verse before that...but I want to show you Isaiah 53, the suffering Servant, all the things that are encoded in that very chapter and particularly starting with this verse, okay.

The word crucifixion is in there; which is really interesting, you know why? Because **crucifixion did not start until the first century BC by the Romans**...there was no crucifixion in ancient days of taking people and crucifying them on a cross or on a tree. There wasn't anything like that. They stoned them to death. So the word crucifixion is there and when Isaiah is writing this around 740-750 BC there is no such thing as crucifixion and yet the word is there. So it shows it has to be by Yahweh. He knows the beginning from the end and by

His prophetic insight mindset that He puts it. The word crucifixion is there; the word resurrection is there, right; crucifixion and resurrection.

The name: **Yahshua is My name** is there and the word Messiah next to that, that Yahshua is the Messiah. Also there, is the eleven original apostles there; the names of all of the apostles: Matthew, Peter, Bartholomew, Jacob...the eleven original apostles are there. There's one apostle missing...who do you think that is? Judas...the one that wasn't there is missing. But you want to know something else? Who took the place of Judas? The Book of Acts, they had to replace him...Matthias...Matthias' name is also there.

So is that amazing...that **eight hundred years before this happens** almost...not only does He name the eleven apostles that Yahshua's going to pick...He leaves out the one who betrays Him...that Yahshua said, "It's better that he was never born" and the one who takes his place, Matthias, is listed in there. And also listed in there is the Apostle Shaul. He's listed as Shaul, not Paul, why...because it's Hebrew...because the name is Hebrew. And the three Mary's from the Brit Chadashah, including Mariam His mother and Mariam, the sister of Lazarus. So you have there...you have the twelve apostles; eleven original and Matthias. You have the three Mariam's; you have **Yahshua is My name**; you have Yahshua is the Messiah; you have the word crucifixion, the word resurrection and all of this right there in Isaiah 53.

There is no other chapter in the entirety of the Tanach that shows the Messiah suffering and dying like Isaiah 53...nothing! And that's why that the Jews, they have a Torah reading every week. They read from the Torah and the Prophets; it's a yearly cycle...it used to be three years...now they do it in one year...but they read every scripture except for Isaiah 53. They go from Isaiah 52 and they jump to Isaiah 54 and they skip Isaiah 53 because it is **so powerful showing that Yahshua is the Messiah**. So out of all scriptures for all this to be encoded in, it's encoded in Isaiah 53...which is just absolutely amazing...absolutely amazing.

Next, let's go to Isaiah 7:14...which scripture...that another amazing scripture, the virgin birth.

Isaiah 7:14 *So, YAHWEH Himself will give you a sign: Behold! The virgin will conceive and will bring forth a son; and she will call His name Immanuel... she will bring forth a son; and call His name Immanuel.*

If you start with the *mem* in that verse, and the *mem* if you look at the word pictures...and I've said this many times, remember Hebrew was originally a pictograph language...the *mem* is actually also a picture of a womb. The *mem* is the picture of the womb; the inside of the womb. So isn't that interesting that it starts with the *mem* where He's talking about the virgin birth and skipping every seventeen letters, it spells the name Mashiach...Mashiach, the Messiah...wow.

Genesis 1:14...Genesis 1:14, right...when Yahweh makes the sun, the moon and the stars...and what are they for? They are for: days and for months; and for holy days. And what do they tell? They tell the whole Plan of Salvation of Yahshua as the Lamb of Yah, slain from the foundation of the world, right...from the beginning going back; to the future going forward; His eternal presence. And isn't it interesting that in that verse...and again, starting with *mem* and *moedim*...if you 172 letters to the left, it spells the name Yahshua. And I'd say, "Well, that's not so impressive. If I go a million letters over here, it's going to do something" but you know what's impressive? If you go 172 letters to the right, it spells Mashiach; **the same exact number of letters**. So 172 letters to the left, spells the name Yahshua; 172 letters to the right spells Mashiach...amazing!

There are codes in the Brit Chadashah in the New Testament...I'm not going to get into that today...but for time-wise...but only in the Aramaic. There are no codes in the Greek; which again shows the primacy of scripture and how one jot or one tittle cannot be removed why? Because when you're doing Equal Distance Spacing of letters and you're skipping, **if you moved one letter out of joint** what would happen? **The whole code would be off**. So again, it proves we have the Bible perfectly. There's nothing that Yahweh left out.

There's nothing that He forgot. We don't need the Book of Enoch. Everything is in there exactly the way that Yahweh put it.

Genesis 1:1...Genesis 1:1...starting with the first *bet*...you know *aleph bet*...*bet* is the second letter of the alphabet. So where would that be? It would be in the word *B'rasheet*. That's the first word in the Bible, *B'rasheet*; "*in the beginning*" that's what it means. So starting with the first *bet* and skipping every 7th letter, spells *Bara*, *B'rasheet Bara Elohim*. *In the beginning Elohim created*...the word *Bara* means *created*. But if you start with the first *bet* and you skip every 7th letter, it will also spell *Bara*, for *created*. Why is that word important? Because I said this before, **that word is only used for Elohim. Elohim is the only Creator**; man is not a creator.

So the fact that *Bara* is encoded is showing Yahweh's signature there. But it's not only that it's encoded once; **it actually happens six times in the creation account**...*Bara, Bara, Bara...Bara, Bara, Bara*. Why is it there six times? Because there's six days of creation and on the seventh day, Yahweh rested...so how amazing...how amazing that He encodes in there Him as the Creator of all six days of creation. I mean it's just Elohim putting His signature on His own creation.

And again, like I said, people can say whatever they want...a human being cannot encode these things and make the thing to make sense. And the fact, that like I said, the Bible wasn't written by just one person. So we can't say Moses encoded this because **the code is all over the Bible and it's written by more than forty different people**. So how on earth can that be? **Over the period of 1500 years, over forty different people** – 44 people...and yet, you see this code over and over and over.

I want to show one more code here...wow, it's amazing how fast time can go by...but I will have to hold some of this other stuff I have for the next time. And like I said, we would have either three parts...but I can tell you now, it'll be four parts because there is just too much good stuff here to let loose.

What I want to go over now is...I want to go over that a code that's here that is just an amazing code that Yahweh put in the Bible and it's starting again in **Genesis 1:1** with *B'rasheet* – *in the Beginning*...so we already saw the code with *Bara*...but now this code, starting with the first *tav* in Genesis 1:1...*tav* is the last letter of the Hebrew alphabet; it's like a "T"...and actually it's the ancient letter was like an "X" or like a cross; and it's the word for covenant, right, it's the *tav*. But if you start with the first *tav*...and again, skipping 49 letters...and that's another thing...that how **many of these codes are all coming out between seven's and seven-seven's – 49**.

So everything was random, why wouldn't there be 23 letters, 643 letters...and that's why I say, there are people that try to put things in the code...they'll take a two-letter word and they'll skip 6,482 letters and eventually you're going to come up with something. But that's not what happening here; because here, like I said, **every code is related to the surface text and every code is perfectly placed there in numeric way that only Yahweh can do it**.

So here it is again, it's 49 letters – seven times seven, 49...so starting with the first *tav* and skipping 49 letters...what does it spell? It spells the word *Torah*...**it spells the word Torah**. And it doesn't just happen once; it happens, not only throughout the Book here that you see this in Book of Genesis, but it also...let's go to Exodus and what do we see? Well, if you go to the Book of **Exodus 1:1**, again, and starting with the first *tav* again, and skipping 49 letters – again, seven times seven, it spells the word *Torah*. What are the chances of that? What are the chances that in Genesis, this is going to happen exactly at 49 letter intervals and of all words it's going to spell the word *Torah*? But then, you get to Exodus and the same thing happens, right? So it's more than just a coincidence because as it happens like this...it's impossible that it would happen like this

at this. So now, we go to the next Book of Leviticus...and it doesn't happen...and hmmm, strange...but we'll get back to Leviticus...there's a reason why it doesn't happen. So let's put Leviticus on the side...but Leviticus it doesn't happen.

And now we get to Numbers...so now when you get to Numbers, and you start, right, in the Book of Numbers and you skip 49 letters, what happens? It spells Torah, but **it spells it backward**. Instead of spelling it T-O-R and A is a vowel that's added there...but A-H...it's H-A-R-O-T, or H-R-O-T. It spells the word Torah in the Hebrew backward; but in 49 letters again...starting in the beginning at 49 letters.

So now we go to Deuteronomy; the last book of the Torah and what happens? Skipping every 49 letters, it spells again Torah, but backwards. So isn't this kind of strange that Genesis and Exodus you have...skipping 49 letters – seven times seven, completeness; you have Torah, Torah. And then Leviticus is in the middle and then you have Numbers and you have Deuteronomy 49 letters – Torah, Torah, but backward...it almost seems like **from Exodus and Genesis, it's pointing one way and then you have Numbers and Deuteronomy and it's pointing another way**.

And I can show you here, this is the matrix that's on it (*visual aid shown*)...this is actually the matrix that you see of it from Genesis...so you could see, like I said, starting with the first *tav* and you could count 49 letters...the 50th letter is the *vav* and then again 49 letters...the 50th letter is the *resh*... 49 letters, the 50th letter is the *hey*...spelling Torah.

So but isn't this interesting...isn't it interesting that you have Genesis and Exodus pointing one way; you have Numbers and Deuteronomy pointing the other way...so why would they be pointing it toward Leviticus? Because Leviticus doesn't have the word Torah, but if you start at the beginning of the Book of Leviticus and you start with the first *yod* and you skip seven letters...right, seven again is the number of completion...**it spells the name YAHWEH – YOD-HEY-VAV-HEY**. So **Yahweh is putting His signature on His Torah**, right? First you have it, Genesis and Exodus – right to left, and then you have Numbers and Deuteronomy – left to right, backward; **all pointing toward Leviticus spelling YOD-HEY-VAV-HEY; Yahweh putting His signature**.

Now you tell me that's a coincidence and I'm going to tell you, you've been hitting the bottle! I mean, c'mon, people could say whatever they want to say. Just like I said last week with creation and when you look at the amount of cells in the body and how they work together and everything has to be perfect or nothing would work in your body. There's no way that that could happen by chance! Anybody that says that...let's go back to the beginning of the message...where was it in **Psalm 14...the fool has said in his heart, there is no Elohim**. That's what I say and believe me, I never call anybody a fool because that's not a word you want to call anybody; although the Bible uses that word a lot, particularly in Proverbs; but there are a lot of fools out there right...there are a lot of fools out there. So, when you're looking at some of these things like this, there is, that the **chances that this could of gotten there by accident is zero**...it's zero! It's impossible, there's no way that that could have got there by accident.

So the Word of Yahweh is so amazing in so many different ways. We're running out of time here so I'm going to have to end for today, but I do want to go...I'll go over one more code with you because I'm trying to stick to codes that just clearly show the Bible and show maybe prophecies of Yahshua whatever...but there are also codes there that are Bible codes of the future.

And there's a whole book that they did on the Bible code and September 11th. And it's absolutely amazing...I'm just going to give you one code from there and then we're going to end for today. But it's in Exodus 32 in verse 28...Exodus 32 in verse 28. Everybody knows what happened on September 11th, right? September 11th was

when terrorists, Arab terrorists let's say, came to the US; they took airplanes, they used them as weapons and they basically hit the Twin Towers and other buildings, the Pentagon; but mainly, the Twin Towers; they took the building down and roughly 3000 people were killed that day.

So what is encoded in this scripture? What's encoded in this scripture is the word **911 – September 11th**, the date is encoded with the year; Twin Towers is encoded; massacre, Ishmael...and if you look in some of the other codes...George Bush's name was there; Osama Bin Laden...I mean basically everything that happened was there...but what did I say? I said that the surface text always relates to the code and what does the text say in Exodus 32:28?

Exodus 32:28 *And the sons of Levi did according to the word of Moses. And about **three thousand men** of the people **fell on that day**.*

That's exactly the amount of people that were killed on 911...wow! Three thousand people fell that day and that's what Yahweh puts; that's the text that's in showing the date, the Twin Towers, who did it and the names and everything. And even George Bush read **Psalms 23** when that happened; and Psalm 23 was also encoded in the September 11th code.

So like I said, how could someone encode something that's going to happen thousands of years down the line? And I do just want to end with a word of caution because like I said, there are people that will manipulate the codes; there are people that will try to force things into the codes that aren't there. They'll try to manipulate the meanings in Hebrew; and that's why I am sticking to the basics. I am sticking to clearly what Yahweh laid out in these codes to show you that if somebody looks at this information I have given you today and they're still going to say that the Bible is not divinely inspired, then show them **Psalms 14**: *the fool has said in his heart, there is no Elohim.*

Because **there is no other explanation than that the Bible was divinely put together from Elohim**. And I wanted to go a little bit...I'll do that the next time...on the Bible Code where I was actually blessed to be part of the filming of they call, *The G-O-D (God) Code*. When they came to Israel I was filmed in there and they show with Tim Smith, the new code that they were coming out with where they're realizing now that the Bible code is a form of DNA. It's a form of DNA of the Bible. So that's what we'll get into next time.

We'll get into the Elohim code that shows about where the sanctuary of Yahweh was and where the Ark of the Covenant was hidden and also going over the DNA of Scripture and some amazing things about the Book of Psalms. So wow, I mean how time can go so fast but when you're looking at the Word of Yahweh, we could have eternity and it wouldn't be enough time.
